

Information for Lehigh Home Game Event Management for Women's Volleyball

SITE: Grace Hall - Asa Packer Campus. *Pets, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, and coolers are not permitted within the building.*

ENTRANCE: Grace Hall – Front doors

PARKING: *Team vehicle parking* and *Spectator parking* is available in any legal parking space: All game day parking for spectators (visitors, parents, friends, alumni) are in the Alumni Parking Pavilion, the Zoellner Arts Center Parking Garage and the Campus Square Garage (bottom level meter parking). Any illegally parked vehicles are subject to be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense. Please lock your vehicle. Lehigh Athletics is not responsible for fire, theft, damage and/or loss of the vehicle or any content.

LOCKER FACILITIES: Located in Taylor Gymnasium on the 3rd floor. The facility will be open 1½ hours before game time. An Event Staff member will meet your team and direct them to the locker room. **No locks or towels will be provided.** Please have your team shower and change directly following the end of the competition. The locker facilities will be available for one hour after an event. Locker rooms are available for team members and official travel party ONLY.

ATHLETIC TRAINING: Sports Medicine Facilities – The host institution's athletic training room will be available to the visiting athletic trainer(s). Any special needs, taping, treatment, or requests must be communicated to the host institution at least 48 hours prior to the contest (Sports Medicine Office: 610-758-4311). A prescription from a doctor or certified athletic trainer is required unless accompanied by a certified athletic trainer. No modalities may be administered by a non-certified student athletic trainer. Ice and water will be available at the site.

PRE-GAME WARM-UPS: Dual Matches: 1 hour prior – shared court 1½ hour prior – each gets 15 minutes (Lehigh gets first 15 minutes, guest gets second 15 minutes). See pre-match protocol on the next page.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Patriot League and Lehigh University policy states:

“Lehigh University and the Patriot League promote good sporting behavior by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators. We encourage everyone to actively support all participants of today's game and ask that you express your enthusiasm in a respectful and sporting-like manner. Please note that the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages (and use of tobacco) also are prohibited. Spectators are not allowed on the playing court at any time.” Thank you. **Our events management staff has the responsibility to enforce this policy and may choose to eject fans that do not comply.**
