

Information for Lehigh Home Game Event Management for Field Hockey

SITE: Ronald J. Ulrich Sports Complex - Murray H. Goodman Campus. Surface – Astroturf (Astroturf will be dry. Court shoes are appropriate for clear weather days. No spikes or cleats on Astroturf.) **Pets, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, and coolers are not permitted within the Ulrich Complex.**

PARKING: All *spectator parking* and *team vehicle parking* will be available in the Stabler Arena parking lots (letter B on map). All parking is subject to change as directed by event staff.

- All game day parking for spectators (visitors, parents, friends, alumni) is in the Stabler Arena Parking Lots. Spectator parking is not permitted in the Cundey Varsity House parking lot. Cundey Varsity House lot is reserved for Lehigh University Student-Athletes, Coaches and game officials only.
- Spectators must park in a legal parking space or in designated areas as directed by parking attendants. Do not block exit ways or fire lanes.
- Parking spaces are available on a first-come, first-serve basis. Patrons are not permitted to save spaces for future arrivals.
- No parking is permitted along Goodman Drive or on the roadway between Rauch Fieldhouse and Stabler Arena
- All parking pass holders for reserved lot areas must display the appropriate parking permit at all times.
- All parking is subject to change as directed by event staff
- Any illegally parked vehicles are subject to be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense
- Please lock your vehicle. Lehigh Athletics is not responsible for fire, theft, damage and/or loss of the vehicle or any content.

LOCKER FACILITIES: Located in Goodman Stadium House. The facility will be open 1½ hours before game time. A locker room attendant will direct your team to the appropriate room. **No locks or towels will be provided.** Please have your team shower and change directly following the end of the competition. The locker facilities will be available for one hour after an event. Locker rooms are available for team members and official travel party ONLY.

ATHLETIC TRAINING: Sports Medicine Facilities – The host institution's athletic training room in Goodman Stadium will be available to the visiting athletic trainer(s). Any special needs, taping, treatment, or requests must be communicated to the host institution at least 48 hours prior to the contest (Sports Medicine Office: 610-758-4311). A prescription from a doctor or certified athletic trainer is required unless accompanied by a certified athletic trainer. No modalities may be administered by a non-certified student athletic trainer. Ice and water will be available at the site.

UNIFORMS: The home team will wear white jerseys and the visiting team will wear dark jerseys.

PRE-GAME WARM-UPS: The field will be available one hour before game time.

TAILGATES & RECEPTIONS: The Lehigh University policy for pre and /or post game gatherings:

- Tailgates are to be in a given a location in a designated parking area. A tailgate is not to last for not more than 1 ½ hours following the end of the competition. **As is true with all tailgating at Lehigh there are no indoor tailgating facilities available.**
- Please encourage your team to shower and use the locker facilities immediately following their competition. The locker facilities will be available for one hour after an event.
- Alcoholic beverages and tobacco are not permitted at any competition site due to Lehigh University, Patriot League, and NCAA policy (only permitted in designated parking area).

SPORTSMANSHIP: Patriot League and Lehigh University policy states:

“Lehigh University and the Patriot League promote good sporting behavior by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators. We encourage everyone to actively support all participants of today's game and ask that you express your enthusiasm in a respectful and sporting-like manner. Please note that the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages (and use of tobacco) also are prohibited.
