SITE: **Grace Hall** – Asa Packer Campus. *Pets, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, and coolers are not permitted within the building.*

Stabler Arena – Murray H. Goodman Campus. *Pets, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, and coolers are not permitted within the building.*

PARKING: *Team vehicle parking* and *Spectator parking* is available in any legal parking space: All game day parking for spectators (visitors, parents, friends, alumni) are in the Alumni Parking Pavilion, the Zoellner Arts Center Parking Garage and the Campus Square Garage (bottom level meter parking). Any illegally parked vehicles are subject to be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense. Please lock your vehicle. Lehigh Athletics is not responsible for fire, theft, damage and/or loss of the vehicle or any content.

Stabler Arena – *Team vehicle parking* will be directed by event staff. *Spectator parking* is available in the Stabler Arena parking lots. All parking is subject to change as directed by event staff.

ENTRANCE: **Grace Hall** -Teams and spectators enter through the front doors.

Stabler Arena - Teams enter through the rear door. Spectators enter through the front doors.

LOCKER FACILITIES: Grace Hall – Located in Room A117. The facility will be open two hours before match time. A locker room attendant will direct your team to the appropriate room. **No locks or towels will be provided.** Please have your team shower and change directly following the end of the competition. The locker facilities will be available for one hour after an event. Locker rooms are available for team members and official travel party ONLY.

Stabler Arena - Located adjacent to the rear doors (#2 on map). The facility will be open two hours before duals or three hours before tournament match time. A locker room attendant will direct your team to the appropriate room. **No locks or towels will be provided.** Please have your team shower and change directly following the end of the competition. The locker facilities will be available for one hour after an event. Locker rooms are available for team members and official travel party ONLY.

ATHLETIC TRAINING: Sports Medicine Facilities – The host institution's athletic training room in Taylor Gym will be available to the visiting athletic trainer(s). Any special needs, taping, treatment, or requests must be communicated to the host institution at least 48 hours prior to the contest (Sports Medicine Office: 610-758-4311). A prescription from a doctor or certified athletic trainer is required unless accompanied by a certified athletic trainer. No modalities may be administered by a non-certified student athletic trainer. Ice and water will be available at the site.

SKIN CHECK/WEIGH-INS: One hour prior to competition. Grace Hall – Located in Taylor Gym on the fourth floor.
Stabler Arena – Located on the second floor

PRE-GAME WARM-UPS: The mat will be available one half hour before match time.

TICKETS: Each team will be provided with 40 complimentary tickets. No requests will be honored later than one hour prior to match time. The player 'will-call' is located in the front lobby of Grace Hall. Tickets will not be issued if forms are not filled out in accordance with NCAA Bylaw 16.2.1.2. Gates open 45 minutes prior to match time.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Lehigh University policy states:

“Lehigh University and the Patriot League promote good sporting behavior by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators. We encourage everyone to actively support all participants of today's game and ask that you express your enthusiasm in a respectful and sporting-like manner.
