

## **PARENTS, FRIENDS AND ALUMNI OF LEHIGH UNIVERSITY RECEPTIONS & TAILGATES:**

We would like to extend our gratitude to all parents, friends, and alumni that come out and support our athletic teams. Our desire is that you enjoy each and every visit to our campus.

The Mistele Family Pavilion and the Rust Family Football Pavilions are for the designated use of Athletic Department teams and participants. These pavilions have been made possible by gifts from parents and alumni. The Rust Family Pavilion was constructed primarily for the use of our football alumni during the football season. It may serve as a site for visiting team tailgating as scheduling permits.

Note: If there are multiple Lehigh groups (i.e. field hockey and soccer), with games at the same time the Mistele Pavilion should be shared by Lehigh groups. Sharing with visiting teams is up to the discretion of the parents.

- Prior to the game; parents can drop off food and beverages [**NON-ALCOHOLIC**] as conditions warrant. Fire lanes prohibit any parking adjacent to the Mistele Family Pavilion. Parents and spectators should park in the Stabler Parking lots.
- There is no parking at anytime along Goodman Drive, in front of Stabler Arena, next to the flag poles, or in front of Rauch Field house. These areas are all designated FIRE LANES.
- The Cundey Varsity House lot is reserved for student athletes, coaches and officials parking only.
- **Alcoholic beverages are not permitted at the Mistele Family Pavilion. If the group wishes to consume alcohol, the reception is now classified as a tailgate and must take place in the parking lots.**
- Alcoholic beverages and tobacco products are not permitted at any competition site due to Lehigh University, Patriot League and NCAA policy (only permitted in designated parking area.)
- All athletes should use the locker room facilities immediately at the conclusion of their game and then join the post-game receptions. Locker rooms will close 30 minutes after the game.
- Pavilion users are responsible for set up, and breakdown of all pre and post game receptions.
- The Athletic Department has provided 6 tables and 50 chairs at the Mistele Pavilion. It is the parent's responsibility to store all tables and chairs in the storage rooms.
- Please use the trash & recycling cans provided. No open goods can be left inside due to the possibility of rodents.
- As with all tailgating at Lehigh; there are no indoor facilities available in the case of bad weather. However, wind/rain curtains are available for use. Please return them to their storage position. Provide are two (2) step stools to assist with the wind/rain curtains.
- Grilling (gas or charcoal) is permitted. A charcoal grill is provided. Please be sure that hot coals are properly disposed and not placed in trash cans that are provided. Due to Bethlehem City fire regulations, portable grills must be at least 10 ft from the Pavilion. Open fires are prohibited.
- The Ulrich Complex will remain open at the conclusion of the game for the convenience of the parents and spectators. Parents can use the water and restrooms inside the Complex.
- It is requested that the parents be responsible for closing the restroom doors and locking the gates to the Ulrich Complex at the conclusion of the post-game reception in the Mistele Family Pavilion.
- In the event of a medical emergency do not call 911, but call Lehigh Police – 610-750-4200. For all non-medical emergencies please see the Athletics Facilities and Event Staff member on duty at the game venue.
