Brian is entering his second season with the Mountain Hawks as an assistant coach after spending two seasons as an assistant at Penn State Behrend. Hirschberg serves as hitting coach for the Mountain Hawks.



John Bisco, Assistant Coach

John begins his third season as an assistant coach with Lehigh, serving primarily as the pitching coach. Before Lehigh, Bisco was the head coach of the Easton Senior Legion baseball team for 12 years, guiding Easton to a 151-133 record. Bisco graduated from LaSalle University in 1977, compiling a 20-5 record on the mound.



Kyle Collina, Assistant Coach

Kyle is entering his second stint as a member of the Lehigh coaching staff after serving as an assistant coach during the 2008 season. Collina, a former pitcher for the Brown and White, rejoins the staff after playing professional baseball in Italy last year. He will serve as an assistant, helping Bisco with the pitchers.

Past camps have also included coaches from the following schools: Penn State Behrend, Stony Brook University, East Stroudsburg University, Muhlenberg College, Swarthmore College and DeSales University

**Sean Leary
Head Baseball Coach**

Sean Leary is now in his 15th season as head coach at Lehigh and 19th overall with the baseball program. He has won 272 games as head coach, second most in school history. In 2006, Leary led the team to its first-ever Patriot League Tournament championship and its first appearance in the NCAA tournament. The 2006 season also gave the Mountain Hawks their second highest win total in school history, second Patriot League co-championship and fifth consecutive appearance in the Patriot League Tournament – a feat never-before accomplished in the program's history. As a result of the team's achievements, Leary was selected as the 2006 Patriot League Coach of the Year for the first time.

Leary has brought a disciplined style of play to the Lehigh program over the past 14 seasons, emphasizing pitching, defense and fundamentals. His players quickly adopted his philosophy, as Lehigh finished 13th in the country in fielding in 1997 – his first season at the helm. Leary brings a wealth of knowledge and a high degree of enthusiasm to the clubhouse, making him one of the brightest young coaches in the Patriot League.
