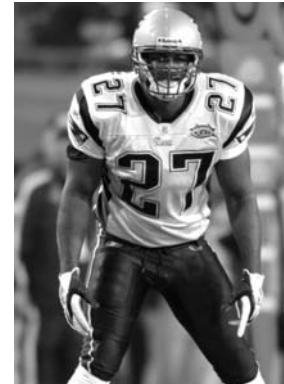

HEAD FOOTBALL COACH, ANDY COEN

Andy Coen enters his fourth season as Lehigh's Head Football Coach. His first season at the helm was a success as the Mountain Hawks captured a share of their 6th Patriot League Championship in the last 9 seasons. Coen's Mountain Hawks lead the Patriot League in both Scoring Offense and Scoring Defense and had a league-best 10 players named 1st Team All-Patriot League.



The 2006 season marked Coen's return to Bethlehem following six seasons as the Offensive Coordinator at the University of Pennsylvania. At Penn, Coen was an instrumental part of three Ivy League Championship seasons as his offenses were among the best in school and league history. Both 2000 and 2002 Quaker offenses set school and league marks for points in a season. During his years at Penn, his offense's produced the school's all-time leading rusher, passer and receiver. Coen coached All-American offensive lineman Jeff Hatch, who was drafted in the third round of the NFL Draft by the New York Giants. His 2003 offensive line, in which all five starters garnered All-Ivy League recognition, lead the Quakers to an undefeated season and finished ranked in the top 10 in 1-AA football.

Prior to his coaching stint in Philadelphia, Coen spent six years as the offensive line coach at Lehigh, including four as the Mountain Hawks offensive coordinator. In his first stop at Lehigh, Coen was a part of two Patriot League Championship teams, including the 1998 squad that finished 12-1 and set a school mark for wins in a season while making it to the NCAA Division 1-AA Quarterfinals. In six seasons, Coen mentored 10 All-Patriot League offensive linemen. During his four years as coordinator, Lehigh's offense finished in the top 10 in passing twice (1996, 1998) and the 1998 squad was 7th in the nation in total offense – racking up 447 yards per game. In addition, the Mountain Hawks produced four consecutive 1,000 yard rushers, including Lehigh's all-time leading rusher Rabih Abdullah.

During his first stop in Bethlehem, Coen was part of a staff that laid the groundwork for a program that has been on one of the most successful runs in all of F.C.S. (1-AA) college football. Since 1998, the Mountain Hawks have compiled an 94-35 record, giving Lehigh the 3rd highest winning percentage of any football program in the country in the last 11 years.
