SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh completes its brief two game road trip this afternoon as the Mountain Hawks head to West Point to take on the Army Black Knights at Christl Arena. Lehigh will look to shake off its 94-83 loss to Navy on Thursday night in Annapolis and snap a five game road losing streak versus Patriot League foes. Freshman C.J. McCollum continues to score in bunches after hitting 11-of-18 shots en route to a career-best tying 31 points versus the Midshipmen. Fellow freshman Gabe Knutson added 16 points for the Brown and White, while senior Marquis Hall and junior Michael Ojo added ten points apiece. Army has won eight straight games at home, including a postseason victory over Lehigh last year, and like the Mountain Hawks is 1-1 in the league. The Black Knights earned their first league win of the year with a hard-fought 67-64 victory over Holy Cross in Massachusetts on Wednesday.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed has totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won over 65-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach for the 2006-07 campaign.

IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will snap a two game losing streak versus Army inside of Christl Arena.
- The Mountain Hawks will improve to 2-1 in league play for the first time since 2007.
- Lehigh will avoid its first losing streak since the first week of December

TODAY'S GAME

Lehigh meets Army for the 89th time this afternoon with the Black Knights leading the series 59-29. The Mountain Hawks have won 12 of the last 17 meetings, but Army has won two straight, including last year's matchup in the Patriot League Tournament quarterfinals.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

WEST POINT, N.Y. (3/4/09) - The Mountain Hawks comeback attempt fell short in a 53-50 loss at Army in the quarterfinal round of the 2009 Patriot League Tournament. For the third straight year a Lehigh - Army postseason game went down to the final seconds, but a 12-point second-half deficit was too much to overcome, as the host Black Knights held onto the lead for the victory. The Mountain Hawks had the ball with 25 seconds to go and were down three, but Marquis Hall misfired on a pair of three-point attempts and sophomore Rob Keefer's attempt at a buzzer beating, game-tying three hit the front of the rim. Zahir Carrington led Lehigh on offense with 14 points and 13 rebounds, while Cleveland Richard netted a game-high 15 points for the Black Knights.

LAST TIME OUT

ANNAPOLIS, Md. - Freshman C.J. McCollum tied his career-high with 31 points but it was not enough as Lehigh saw its six-game win streak come to an end with a 94-83 loss to Navy on Thursday. McCollum sank 11-of-18 shots from the floor and six-of-eight at the line but the Midshipmen shot 87% from the free throw line and put up 58 second half points to earn the win. Along with McCollum freshman Gabe Knutson (16), senior Marquis Hall (10) and junior Michael Ojo (10) hit for double figures. Navy was led by Chris Harris' 29 tallies.

PUTTING POINTS ON THE BOARD

During its last six games Lehigh is averaging 80.7 points on 47.7% shooting. The last time Lehigh scored 70+ points in six consecutive games was 1994. The Brown and White finished that season with 10 straight games of 70 or more points. Lehigh, which scored a season-best 89 points in its win at Longwood, currently ranks second in the Patriot League in scoring offense at 72.9 points per contest.

LIKE NIGHT AND DAY

Lehigh has won seven of eight home games this season and allowed 68.0 points per game on 39% shooting at Stabler Arena. On the road has been a different story for the Mountain Hawks however, who are just 3-6 away from home and allowing teams to score 77.4 points on 45% shooting.

SEE C.J. SCORE

Freshman C.J. McCollum continues to torch the nets with his scoring ability. The lanky 6-3 freshman tied his career-high with his 31-point performance at Navy on Thursday, and currently ranks fourth in the Patriot League in scoring at 15.1 ppg. In his last six games McCollum is averaging 21.2 points and shooting 57% from the floor and 52% from three. His 31 points are the most by a Lehigh freshman since Daren Queenan poured in 31 versus Bucknell in the 1985 East Coast Conference Tournament.

TIGHT ENCOUNTERS

When Lehigh and Army get together, a low-scoring, physical affair usually ensues. In their last 12 games versus one another the average margin of victory has been just 7.7 points, and two of the games have gone to overtime. Lehigh has won seven of those 12 contests, but the Black Knights have emerged victorious in both overtime games.

CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Marquis Hall and Zahir Carrington continue to climb the all-time leaderboard for Lehigh and the Patriot League. Hall is 22 points away from moving into the top-ten on the school's scoring list, while his 473 assists are sixth best in league annals. Carrington has scored 1,059 career points, which places him 23rd on Lehigh's list. The Philadelphia native is also 73 rebounds away from moving into tenth place in league history.

WHAT HAPPENED AFTER HALFTIME?

Lehigh trailed Navy by only three at halftime of its game on Thursday, 36-33. In the second half however the Mountain Hawks defense surrendered 58 points on 55% shooting from the floor and three-point range. The 58 points were the most Lehigh has allowed in a half since Brett Reed's first game as head coach when Cornell netted 58 second half tallies in Ithaca in 2007.

SCOUTING THE BLACK KNIGHTS...

Head coach Zach Spiker (Ithaca '00) is in his first season as the leader of the Army program ... with a win today the Black Knights will establish their longest home winning strak since moving to Christl Arena for the 1985-86 season ... Army has the Patriot League's stingiest defense this year, allowing only 58.9 points per game ... Army and Lehigh rank one-two in the league in field goal percentage defense (.383/.433) ... Lehigh and Army took on two common opponents during the non-league portion of their schedules, including Yale and Dartmouth.

BALANCED ATTACK

In 29 games a season ago Lehigh was led in scoring by five different players and in rebounding by six. This season, seven Mountain Hawks have led the squad in scoring and eight Mountain Hawks have led the team in rebounds.

MARCHING TO THE LINE

The Mountain Hawks have shot 58 more free throws and made 73 more than their opponents this season. Lehigh, which is shooting 70% at the stripe, has attempted more free throws than its opponent in 11 games, including a season best 40 vs. NJIT. Freshman Holden Greiner is shooting a team best 90% at the line.

HELPING HAND

Lehigh is currently second in the Patriot League in assists, averaging 15.0 per game. The Mountain Hawks have totaled 20 or more helpers in four games and 15 or more nine times. Senior Marquis Hall, who has four games of double digit assists this season, ranks among the national leaders with 5.5 assists per game.

GABE'S GAME CONTINUES TO GROW

Freshman Gabe Knutson had a solid start to his Lehigh career, averaging 7.5 points and 6.9 rebounds in his first 13 games. In his last four games though, Knutson has caught fire, averaging 15.5 points on 59% shooting. During that time the Iowa native has scored in double figures each game, including a season best 23 points vs. NJIT.

UP NEXT...

Lehigh returns to Stabler Arena on Wednesday evening when the Mountain Hawks welcome Colgate to town. Tip-off on January 20 is set for 7:05 from the STAR as Lehigh looks for its seventh straight win at home vs. the Raiders.

Head coach Brett Reed has announced the Lehigh basketball class of 2014. The three newest Mountain Hawks will arrive on campus in the fall of 2010. They include:

Anthony D'Orazio: 6-2 guard from Camden Catholic High School (N.J.) ... as a junior, averaged 14.7 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists, while shooting 47% from the floor ... First-Team Olympic Conference and was named the MVP of the Olympic Cape Challenge and the Prime Time Shootout.

Mackey McKnight: 6-0 point guard from Langham Creek High School (Texas) ... as a junior, averaged 14.6 points, 6.8 assists and 4.3 rebounds per game while shooting 40% from three-point range ... District MVP Runner Up and First-Team All-District honors ... also named to the All-Regional Team.

Kevin McCarthy: 6-9 center who graduated from De La Salle Collegiate High School (Mich.) and is currently attending Philips Exeter Academy (N.H.) ... averaged 10.2 points, 8.2 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game last season ... First-Team All-District and All-League and Second-Team All-State.

NON-LEAGUE SUCCESS

With its win vs. Yale on January 5 Lehigh earned its ninth win of the season. The Mountain Hawks' 19 non-league victories over the course of the past two seasons are their most in a two-year span since the inception of the Patriot League.
