#### SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh looks to pull its record even this evening as the Mountain Hawks play host to the Monmouth Hawks at Stabler Arena. Lehigh downed Quinnipiac 79-71 on November 18 at home behind a season-high 22 points from freshman C.J. McCollum and a second straight 10-assist performance by senior captain Marquis Hall. McCollum currently leads the Brown and White in scoring at 15.7 points per game. Monmouth, which is in the midst of playing seven consecutive games away from home, has been off since playing a 6:00 AM contest at Saint Peter's on November 17. The Hawks fell to the Peacocks 58-34 that morning with Travis Taylor leading the New Jersey school in scoring for the third consecutive contest.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed has totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won over 65-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach for the 2006-07 campaign.

#### IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will defeat Monmouth for the second straight season, and the third straight time at Stabler Arena.
- The Mountain Hawks will improve to 7-3 during the last two Novembers.
- Brett Reed will improve his record to 6-2 versus schools from the Northeast Conference.

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

Lehigh and Monmouth meet for the sixth time this evening with the Mountain Hawks leading the series 4-1. The Brown and White won last year's matchup in New Jersey 80-71 while in 2007 Lehigh prevailed 56-39 at Stabler Arena. Monmouth's lone win in the series came in New Jersey in 2006, a 67-39 victory.

**THE LAST MEETING**

MONMOUTH, N.J. (12/21/08) - Lehigh led from the opening tap to the final buzzer and left Boylan Gym with an 80-71 victory over the Monmouth Hawks. Lehigh held a 30-point advantage in the first half, but had it cut to single digits in the second half before holding on for its second straight win. Marquis Hall led Lehigh with 23 points, while Phil Anderson added a career-best 16. Yaniv Simpson scored a game-high 25 points for the Hawks.

**LAST TIME OUT**

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - Freshman C.J. McCollum received his first career start and the Ohio native did not disappoint as he hit for a game-high 22 points on 9-of-16 shooting to lift Lehigh to a 79-71 victory over Quinnipiac in the Mountain Hawks' home opener at Stabler Arena. Rob Keefer added 13 points off the bench, while classmate Michael Ojo hit for 11. Quinnipiac's James Feldeine matched McCollum with 22 points of his own and he also pulled down ten rebounds for the Bobcats. After Lehigh went in front by 12 with 3:22 to go, Quinnipiac refused to go away, as Justin Rutty sank a jumper and Deontay Twyman nailed a long three to make the score 69-65 with 1:50 on the clock. Lehigh hit its free throws down the stretch however and held on for the win.

**GLASS EATERS**

Zahir Carrington pulled down 8.6 boards per game last season, which led the Patriot League. It marked the fourth consecutive season a Mountain Hawk has ranked in the top-three in rebounding in the league after former captain Bryan White '08 ranked first in '07-08, second in '06-07 and third in '05-06.

**CLAMPING DOWN**

The Mountain Hawks defense returned to form last season as they led the Patriot League and ranked 13th nationally in field goal percentage defense at 39%. Lehigh held 14 opponents below the 40% mark from the field a season ago and limited Richmond to 38.6% in the opener.

**SIGHTS SET ON THE TOP SPOT**

Senior captain Marquis Hall has dished out 405 assists during his three-plus seasons in the Brown and White, good for an average of 4.4 per game. Hall, who has totaled 118 or more assists in each of his three years at Lehigh, needs 48 helpers to break the school record of 452 set by Scott Layer from 1986-90. He equaled his career-high with ten assists at Rider and again vs. Quinnipiac.

**MOUNTAIN HAWKS SET MARK FOR NON-LEAGUE WINS**

Lehigh won a school record ten non-league games a season ago, including its first victory over a Big East member (Rutgers). The Mountain Hawks five non-league road victories were the most since the inception of Patriot League play in 1990.

**HALL UP FOR LOWE'S SENIOR CLASS AWARD**

Marquis Hall was recently named a candidate for the 2009-10 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, presented annually to an NCAA Division I student-athlete in nine sports. Hall is one of 60 basketball players from around the country who was chosen (30 male and 30 female). Based on criteria focusing on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition, the award winners will be selected by national balloting of head basketball coaches, national media and college basketball fans.

**BENCH PATROL**

At Rider Lehigh received 49 of its 71 points from its bench led by junior Michael Ojo's career-best 14 points. The 49 bench points were the Mountain Hawks' most under Brett Reed. Through three games Lehigh's non-starters are averaging 37.0 points, led by junior Michael Ojo's 9.7 points per game.

**SCOUTING THE HAWKS...**

Head coach Dave Calloway is in his 13th season at his alma mater (Monmouth '87). He has led the Hawks to three NCAA Tournament appearances ... senior guard Whitney Coleman missed all of last season due to injury ... the Hawks were selected to finish ninth in the 12-team Northeast Conference ... Monmouth has led the NEC in scoring defense in 14 of the last 21 years ... Lehigh and Monmouth will take on three common opponents this season, including Rider, Quinnipiac and St. Francis (Pa.).

**CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN**

Head Coach Brett Reed has announced seniors Dave Buchberger, Zahir Carrington, Marquis Hall and Matt Shamis are captains for the 2009-10 season.

**RETURNING LEADERS**

Several returning Mountain Hawks ranked among the Patriot League statistical leaders a season ago. Included on that list is Zahir Carrington who ranked first in rebounding, fourth in scoring, and ninth in blocked shots, Marquis Hall who finished third in assists, and fifth in scoring, made three-pointers, assist/turnover ratio and steals, Prentice Small who checked in at number two in assist/turnover ratio and eight in assists, and Dave Buchberger who finished second in free throw shooting.

**SHINING DEBUT**

Freshman C.J. McCollum came to Lehigh with a reputation for scoring the basketball and the Ohio native has lived up to that billing in the early going, scoring 12 points in the opener, 13 more at Rider and a season best 22 in the win over Quinnipiac. McCollum is shooting 51% from the field and has sank nine three-pointers through two games. McCollum's 12 points were the most by an LU frosh in his collegiate debut since current junior Prentice Small hit for 13 in the 2007-08 opener at Cornell.

During the 2009 spring semester, four Mountain Hawks achieved a grade point average of 3.2 or better. The list included Dave Buchberger (3.58), Marquis Hall (3.23), Rob Keefer (3.21) and Matt Szalachowski '09 (3.50). Hall was also named the 2009 Patriot League Men's Basketball Scholar Athlete of the Year - the first time a Lehigh men's basketball student-athlete earned this award.
