### GAME FOURTEEN: LEHIGH VS NJIT

#### SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh looks to continue its winning ways this evening as the Mountain Hawks welcome the NJIT Highlanders to Stabler Arena. Lehigh is shooting for its fourth straight victory after going 2-0 on a long road trip earlier this week. The Brown and White downed Delaware State in overtime on Wednesday by a score of 73-66 as seniors Marquis Hall (20) and Dave Buchberger (15) combined for 35 points and freshman C.J. McCollum added 16 tallies. The Mountain Hawks overcame a ten-point second half deficit to force the extra session and outscored the Hornets 14-7 in OT to earn their second straight road win. NJIT was also in action on Wednesday as the Highlanders earned their fifth victory as they defeated NYU-Poly 67-31 at home. Chris Flores led the charge with 18 points.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed has totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won over 65-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach for the 2006-07 campaign.

#### IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will improve to 3-0 all-time versus NJIT.
- The Mountain Hawks will win four straight games for the first time since winning five straight during December 2008/January 2009.
- Lehigh will improve its record to 25-17 under head coach Brett Reed versus non-league foes.

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

Lehigh has played NJIT only twice before with the Mountain Hawks winning both games. Lehigh earned a 66-38 victory last season in New Jersey.

**THE LAST TIME THEY MET**

NEWARK, N.J. (12/31/08) - Lehigh improved to 9-3 for the first time since 1925 with a 66-38 victory over the NJIT Highlanders at the Fleischer Center. The Mountain Hawks used a stifling defensive effort to hold the Highlanders to 11 total field goals and 22-percent shooting, and a balanced offensive attack, led by sophomore Michael Ojo's career-high 14-point effort to earn their fourth consecutive victory. Lehigh held NJIT scoreless for the first 6:11 of the game and raced out to a 12-0 lead. A 30-17 halftime lead ballooned to 20 and eventually the final margin of 28.

**LAST TIME OUT**

DOVER, Del. - Lehigh won its third straight game with a hard-fought 73-66 victory in overtime against the Delaware State Hornets at Memorial Hall on Wednesday evening. Seniors Marquis Hall (20) and Dave Buchberger (15) combined for 35 points, while freshman C.J. McCollum scored 16 as the Mountain Hawks overcame a ten-point second half deficit to improve to 7-6 on the season. Delaware State was led by Frisco Sandidge's 17 points. With 8:27 remaining in regulation Sandidge threw down a dunk that gave the home team a ten-point lead, but Hall responded with a three and baskets by Buchberger and Rob Keefer got Lehigh within three. Two straight scores by Buchberger with under two minutes to play put Lehigh on top by three, but DSU's Jay Threatt hit a three with five seconds to go, sending the game to overtime. In the extra session Lehigh outscored DSU 14-7.

**HALL EYES THE TOP SPOT**

Senior captain Marquis Hall is close to breaking the school record of 452 assists, held by Scott Layer (1986-90). Hall has totaled 448 helpers during his time in the Brown and White, which is ninth in league history and five shy of the Lehigh mark. In addition, Hall's 5.3 per-game average this season ranks in the top-50 nationally.

**THAT'S MORE LIKE IT**

After losing three straight earlier this season Lehigh sat at 3-5 overall, but since then the Mountain Hawks have run off four wins in the last five to move above .500 at 7-6. During those five games Lehigh is averaging 72.0 points on 44% shooting while out-rebounding its opponents by over three per game. Lehigh has outscored its opponents 169-148 in the first half and held them to 40.4% shooting overall.

**ON TARGET**

During its two game road trip Lehigh connected on 61-of-115 shots from the floor (.530) and shot over 50% in both contests. The last time the Mountain Hawks shot better than 50% in two straight was the first two games of the 2008-09 season.

**CALL IT A COMEBACK**

After trailing 37-36 to Longwood at halftime Lehigh reeled off 53 second half points to earn the road win on Monday. The 53 points were the most the Mountain Hawks have scored in a half this season as they shot a blistering 62.5% (20-32) from the floor. On Wednesday Lehigh was at it again, overcoming a 30-28 halftime deficit to defeat Delaware State 73-66 in overtime, powered by a 12-of-23 (52%) showing from the floor in the second half. It marks the first time since January 2008 that the Mountain Hawks have won two straight games after trailing at halftime.

**NOT SO HAPPY NEW YEAR**

Lehigh is only 4-4 in the first game of the New Year during the last eight seasons. The Mountain Hawks downed Columbia 73-59 last year on January 2 but lost the previous two seasons to Columbia on the same day.

**BUCHBERGER IS BACK ON TRACK**

Senior captain Dave Buchberger did not reach double figures in any of Lehigh's first seven games, but has done it three times in the last six contests. In those six games Buchberger is averaging 9.5 points on 65% shooting, and he has hit 10-of-19 from beyond the arc. The native of Cincinnati scored a season best 15 points in the win at Delaware State, connecting on six-of-seven field goal attempts.

**SCOUTING THE HIGHLANDERS...**

Head coach Jim Engles is in his second season as the leader of the NJIT program ... only one of the Highlanders' five wins this season has come on the road ... NJIT has outscored its opponents 378-374 in the first half of games this season, but has been outscored 442-395 in the second half ... the Highlanders have held five opponents to fewer than 60 points ... Chris Flores has led NJIT in scoring in five of past seven games after not leading them in scoring in any of the first six games ... Lehigh and NJIT will take on three common opponents this season, including Lafayette, Stony Brook, and Yale.

**POINTS A'PLENTY**

Lehigh scored a season-high 89 points in the win over Longwood, marking the second time this season the Mountain Hawks have scored 80+ points. The 89 points were Lehigh's most since totaling 96 in a win over Swarthmore on November 29, 2006.

**GETTING ON THE GLASS**

After being out-rebounded in seven of its first nine games Lehigh has grabbed more rebounds than its opponent in four straight contests. During that time the Mountain Hawks have averaged 41.8 boards, which are 6.0 more than the opposition. Zahir Carrington has led the way with an 11.0 per game average.

**SHINING STAR AT STABLER**

Lehigh head coach Brett Reed is 23-11 at Stabler Arena during his two-plus years at the helm. Reed's win percentage of 67.6% at the STAR ranks third all-time in school annals behind Billy Taylor (76%) and Fran McCaffery (73%).

**CARRINGTON JOINS 1,000 PT CLUB**

Senior Zahir Carrington threw down a second half dunk on Monday to give the Philadelphia native exactly 1,000 career points. Carrington is the 28th member of Lehigh's 1,000-point club and the first since classmate Marquis Hall accomplished the feat last year. Carrington now has 1,006 points and will be honored prior to tonight's game for this milestone.

**UP NEXT...**

Lehigh remains at home and closes out its non-league schedule when the Mountain Hawks host Yale on Tuesday evening. It marks the first time since the 1999-00 season that the two teams will meet. Tip-off on January 5 is set for 7:05.

Head coach Brett Reed has announced the Lehigh basketball class of 2014. The three newest Mountain Hawks will arrive on campus in the fall of 2010. They include:

*Anthony D'Orazio:* 6-2 guard from Camden Catholic High School (N.J.) ... as a junior, averaged 14.7 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists, while shooting 47% from the floor ... First-Team Olympic Conference and was named the MVP of the Olympic Cape Challenge and the Prime Time Shootout.

*Mackey McKnight:* 6-0 point guard from Langham Creek High School (Texas) ... as a junior, averaged 14.6 points, 6.8 assists and 4.3 rebounds per game while shooting 40% from three-point range ... District MVP Runner Up and First-Team All-District honors ... also named to the All-Regional Team.

*Kevin McCarthy:* 6-9 center who graduated from De La Salle Collegiate High School (Mich.) and is currently attending Philips Exeter Academy (N.H.) ... averaged 10.2 points, 8.2 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game last season ... First-Team All-District and All-League and Second-Team All-State.

**HITTING THE BOOKS**

During the 2009 spring semester, four Mountain Hawks achieved a grade point average of 3.2 or better. The list included Dave Buchberger (3.58), Marquis Hall (3.23), Rob Keefer (3.21) and Matt Szalachowski '09 (3.50). Hall was also named the 2009 Patriot League Men's Basketball Scholar Athlete of the Year - the first time a Lehigh men's basketball student-athlete earned this award.

**COAST TO COAST**
