### GAME NINETEEN: LEHIGH VS COLGATE

**LEHIGH MOUNTAIN HAWKS (11-7, 2-1 PL) VS COLGATE RAIDERS (5-12, 1-2 PL)**  
**STABLER ARENA (5,600) • BETHLEHEM, PA**  
**JANUARY 20, 2010 • 7:00 PM**

#### SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh returns home tonight to face the Colgate Raiders at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks went 1-1 last week, including a 73-55 victory over Army on Sunday afternoon in West Point in a game in which the Brown and White placed four players in double figures and limited the Black Knights to 33% shooting from the floor. Senior Zahir Carrington led the offense with 20 points, while classmate Marquis Hall totaled 15 points, seven rebounds and seven assists. After defeating Army in its league opener on January 9 Colgate has since dropped two straight contests, including a 73-63 defeat to American on Sunday in the nation's capital. Kyle Roemer and Yaw Gyawu combined for 41 points in the loss and enter tonight's game averaging over 34 points per game between them. One of those two potent scorers has led the Raiders in scoring in 15 of the team's 17 games.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed has totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won over 65-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach for the 2006-07 campaign.

#### IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will improve to 8-1 at Stabler Arena for the first time since 2004.
- The Mountain Hawks will improve to 3-1 in league play for the first time since 2007.
- Lehigh will defeat Colgate at home for the seventh consecutive time.

## TONIGHT'S GAME

Lehigh and Colgate meet for the 73rd time this evening with the Raiders holding a 44-28 series lead. The Mountain Hawks snapped a two game losing streak versus the Raiders with a hard-fought win at Stabler Arena last season and overall have won the past six matchups at the STAR.

### THE LAST TIME THEY MET

BETHLEHEM, Pa. (2/18/09) - Lehigh emerged from a defensive battle with a 49-40 victory over Colgate at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks limited the Raiders to 17 points and 20% shooting in the second half as they earned victory number 15 to surpass last year's total. Junior Marquis Hall led the Brown and White with 16 points, while Colgate received a team-high 13 points from Mike Venezia. Lehigh shot only 37% for the game, while Colgate hit on 27% of its attempts.

### LAST TIME OUT

WEST POINT, N.Y. - Four Lehigh players scored in double figures and the Mountain Hawks held Army to 33% shooting as the Brown and White downed the Black Knights 73-55 on Sunday afternoon at Christl Arena. Senior Zahir Carrington led the Mountain Hawks with a season best 20 points, while fellow seniors Marquis Hall and Dave Buchberger added 15 and 12, respectively, and freshman C.J. McCollum scored 13. Cleveland Richard was the lone Black Knight in double figures with 11. Army closed to within ten at 54-44, but Lehigh ripped off ten straight points in a matter of 3:03 to up 64-44 and the Brown and White never looked back from there. With the win Lehigh snapped a two game losing streak versus Army in West Point.

## OFFENSE CONTINUES TO ROLL

During its last seven games Lehigh is averaging 79.6 points on 47.4% shooting. **The last time Lehigh scored 70+ points in seven consecutive games was 1994. The Brown and White finished that season with 10 straight games of 70 or more points.** Lehigh, which scored a season-best 89 points in its win at Longwood, currently ranks second in the Patriot League in scoring offense at 72.9 points per contest.

## OFF AND RUNNING FROM THE STAR

At 7-1, Lehigh is off to its best start at Stabler Arena since the 2003-04 season when it went a school best 13-1 at the STAR. During their eight games at home this season the Mountain Hawks have averaged 73.5 points on 44% shooting and are sporting a +2.3 turnover margin. Three players, including C.J. McCollum (14.4), Zahir Carrington (11.0) and Marquis Hall (10.8), are averaging double figures in points.

## MORE HONORS FOR MCCOLLUM

Freshman C.J. McCollum was honored for the fourth time by the Patriot League on Monday as he collected yet another Rookie of the Week honor. The Ohio native, who ranks 14th nationally among freshmen in scoring, averaged 22.0 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists last week, including his second 31-point effort in a ten day span. McCollum is the first Lehigh freshman to post two 30-point games in the same season since the school's all-time leading scorer, Daren Queenan '88, did it in 1985.

## HANDLING WITH CARE

During Patriot League play Lehigh is averaging only 11.7 turnovers per game and is sporting a +2.3 turnover margin. Overall for the season the Mountain Hawks are second in the league in assist/turnover ratio (1.1) and third in turnovers per game (13.3).

## ASSISTED WINNING

In Lehigh's 11 wins the Mountain Hawks are averaging 16.1 assists on 26.0 made field goals, good for 61.9%. In the team's seven losses they are averaging 12.9 helpers on 22.5 made field goals (57.3%). Lehigh has nine games of 15 or more assists this season and is 7-2 in those games.

## IS THERE A LID ON THE BASKET?

In the last nine meetings between Lehigh and Colgate the average score has been a pedestrian-like 56 to 54 in favor of the Mountain Hawks. During that time only once has a team scored more than 70 points (Colgate, 2008). In their last four trips to Bethlehem the Raiders have not scored more than 60 points in any of the games, bottoming out with last year's 40-point performance.

## SCOUTING THE RAIDERS...

Head coach Emmett Davis is in his 12th season at the helm of the Colgate program ... only one of the Raiders' five wins this season has come on the road ... Colgate currently leads the league in defensive rebounds, averaging 32.9 per contest ... the Raider's last regular season Patriot League road victory came on January 10, 2009 at Army ... Yaw Gyawu ranks second in the P.L. in field goal percentage (.516) and fourth in scoring (15.3) ... during the non-league portions of their schedule, Lehigh and Colgate took on four common opponents, including Yale, Stony Brook, Dartmouth, and Longwood.

**SHINING STAR AT STABLER**

Lehigh head coach Brett Reed is 26-11 at Stabler Arena during his two-plus years at the helm. Reed's win percentage of 70.2% at the STAR ranks third all-time in school annals behind Billy Taylor (76%) and Fran McCaffery (73%).

**BACK TO BASICS**

Lehigh's defense held Army to 55 points on 33% shooting in the win on Sunday. The 55 points are the fewest the Mountain Hawks have surrendered since last year's Patriot League Tournament when Army scored 53 and the 33% shooting performance was the lowest since Colgate shot 26% in February of 2009 here in Bethlehem. Lehigh is currently second in the Patriot League in field goal percentage defense (.422%).

**OPPORTUNISTIC OFFENSE**

Lehigh forced Army into 15 turnovers and outscored the Black Knights 18-7 in points off of turnovers. In their 11 victories the Mountain Hawks have outscored their opponents a combined 158-104 in this category, including a season best 23-5 in the win over Monmouth.

**MARCHING TO THE LINE**

The Mountain Hawks have shot 85 more free throws and made 69 more than their opponents this season. Lehigh, which is shooting 70% at the stripe, has attempted more free throws than its opponent in 12 games, including a season best 40 vs. NJIT. Freshman Holden Greiner is shooting a team best 90% at the line.

**UP NEXT...**

Lehigh stays at home to face archrival Lafayette on Saturday evening. The Mountain Hawks and Leopards will tip things off at 7:05 on January 23 as Lehigh looks to pay its rival back for last year's loss at the STAR.
