#### SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh opens a new season tonight as the Mountain Hawks head to Virginia to face a stiff test versus the Richmond Spiders out of the Atlantic-10. Lehigh returns four starters, including a pair of All-Patriot League selections in Marquis Hall and Zahir Carrington, from a season ago in which the Mountain Hawks won 15 games, including the most non-league contests in school annals. The Spiders meanwhile, bring back a potent backcourt of Kevin Anderson and David Gonzalvez which averaged over 30 points between them a season ago for a team that won 20 games and advanced to the semifinal round of the CBI (College Basketball Invitational). Tonight's game is only the second meeting all-time between these schools and it marks the seventh time in the last nine seasons the Mountain Hawks have started a season away from home.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed has totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won over 65-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach for the 2006-07 campaign.

#### IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will defeat a team from the Atlantic-10 for the first time since the inception of the league in 1976.
- The Mountain Hawks will improve to 2-1 in season openers under Brett Reed.
- Lehigh will improve to 6-2 in non-league road games since the start of last season.

## TONIGHT'S GAME

Lehigh and Richmond meet for the second time in the teams' history tonight. Lehigh lost vs. the Spiders in the first-ever meeting between the two teams.

### THE LAST MEETING

Lehigh lost to the Richmond Spiders in a close match-up 40-38 in the only meeting, which took place in 1940.

### LAST TIME OUT

WEST POINT, N.Y. - (3/4/2009) The Mountain Hawks comeback attempt fell short in a 53-50 loss at Army. For the third straight year a Lehigh-Army Patriot League tournament game went down to the final seconds, but a 12-point second half deficit for the Mountain Hawks was too much to overcome, as the host Black Knights held onto the lead for the victory and advancement in post season play. The Mountain Hawks crept within a point on two separate occasions and had the basketball down by three with 25 seconds remaining, but junior Marquis Hall misfired on a pair of three point attempts, and sophomore Rob Keefer's attempt at a buzzer-beating, game-tying three hit the front of the rim. With the victory Army improved to 11-18 on the season and moved into the semifinal round, while Lehigh's season came to an end at 15-14. In the second half, Army's lead ballooned as high as 12 points before Lehigh began its comeback. A Rob Keefer lay up and jumper from John Adams put the Mountain Hawks within five, while a Hall free throw left LU down four with just under eight minutes to go. Adams scored two straight buckets to get Lehigh within a point, but the Mountain Hawks would get no closer as their season came to an end.

### GLASS EATERS

Zahir Carrington pulled down 8.6 boards per game last season, which led the Patriot League. It marked the fourth consecutive season a Mountain Hawk has ranked in the top-three in rebounding in the league after former captain Bryan White '08 ranked first in '07-08, second in '06-07 and third in '05-06.

### CLAMPING DOWN

The Mountain Hawks defense returned to form last season as they led the Patriot League and ranked 13th nationally in field goal percentage defense at 39%. Lehigh held 14 opponents below the 40% mark from the field a season ago.

### SIGHTS SET ON THE TOP SPOT

Senior captain Marquis Hall has dished out 379 assists during his first three seasons in the Brown and White, good for an average of 4.3 per game. Hall, who has totaled 118 or more assists in each of his three years at Lehigh, needs 74 helpers to break the school record of 452 set by Scott Layer from 1986-90.

### MOUNTAIN HAWKS SET MARK FOR NON-LEAGUE WINS

Lehigh won a school record ten non-league games a season ago, including its first victory over a Big East member (Rutgers). The Mountain Hawks five non-league road victories were the most since the inception of Patriot League play in 1990.

### HALL UP FOR LOWE'S SENIOR CLASS AWARD

Marquis Hall was recently named a candidate for the 2009-10 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, presented annually to an NCAA Division I student-athlete in nine sports. Hall is one of 60 basketball players from around the country who was chosen (30 male and 30 female). Based on criteria focusing on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition, the award winners will be selected by national balloting of head basketball coaches, national media and college basketball fans.

### SCOUTING THE SPIDERS...

Richmond head coach Chris Mooney (Princeton '94) is in his fifth season at the helm. He has enjoyed previous coaching stops at Beaver College and Air Force ... Richmond set the school record for points in a season with 2,518 during the 2008-09 season ... the Spiders were selected to finish third in the Atlantic-10 this season; it is their highest preseason pick since joining the league for the 2001-02 season ... three Spiders, including Kevin Anderson (1st), David Gonzalez (2nd) and Dan Geriot (3rd) were selected as members of the preseason All-Atlantic-10 squad ... Lehigh and Richmond will take on four common opponents this season, including Longwood, Bucknell, Saint Joseph's and Dayton

**RAISE THE CURTAIN**

Lehigh is 61-47 all-time in season openers. Last season the Mountain Hawks went to Saint Peter's and downed the Peacocks 79-62 behind a combined 41 points from Zahir Carrington and Marquis Hall. Lehigh has not won back-to-back openers since the 1998-99 and 1999-00 seasons.

**CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN**

Head Coach Brett Reed has announced seniors Dave Buchberger, Zahir Carrington, Marquis Hall and Matt Shamis will be captains for the 2009-10 season.

**RETURNING LEADERS**

Several returning Mountain Hawks ranked among the Patriot League statistical leaders a season ago. Included on that list is Zahir Carrington who ranked first in rebounding, fourth in scoring, and ninth in blocked shots, Marquis Hall who finished third in assists, and fifth in scoring, made three-pointers, assist/turnover ratio and steals, Prentice Small who checked in at number two in assist/turnover ratio and eight in assists, and Dave Buchberger who finished second in free throw shooting.

During the 2009 spring semester, four Mountain Hawks achieved a grade point average of 3.2 or better. The list included Dave Buchberger (3.58), Marquis Hall (3.23), Rob Keefer (3.21) and Matt Szalachowski '09 (3.50).
