#### SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh completes its Atlantic-10 tour this evening as the Mountain Hawks head to Philadelphia to take on the Saint Joseph's Hawks. Lehigh returned from its annual final exams break on Thursday and snapped its three game losing skid with a 66-58 victory over Dartmouth at Stabler Arena. Senior captain Marquis Hall netted a game-high 17 points, while junior Michael Ojo came off the bench and tied his career-high with 14 tallies, including a perfect six-of-six showing at the foul line. Saint Joseph's has been off since falling 97-74 at Big Ten member Minnesota on December 12 in Minneapolis. Three Hawks, including Darrin Govens (15), Garrett Williamson (15) and Chris Prescott (14) netted double figures. Tonight's contest is only the third for Saint Joseph's inside the new Michael J. Hagan '85 Arena.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed has totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won over 65-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach for the 2006-07 campaign.

#### IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will defeat a team from the Atlantic-10 for the first time since the inception of the league in 1976.
- The Mountain Hawks will defeat Saint Joseph's for the first time in school history.
- Lehigh will improve to 22-16 versus non-league foes under head coach Brett Reed.

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

Lehigh meets Saint Joseph's for the 14th time this evening, but just the second time since 1982. The Hawks lead the series 13-0, including a 77-64 victory last season in Bethlehem. The teams first met in 1959, an 85-63 win by Saint Joseph's.

**THE LAST TIME THEY MET**

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - Lehigh hung tough with Saint Joseph's at Stabler Arena, but in the end the Hawks outlasted the Brown and White 77-64. Ahmad Nivins scored a game-high 20 points and ripped down 17 rebounds for the Hawks as they improved to 3-3. Juniors Marquis Hall and Zahir Carrington combined for 31 points for Lehigh, but it wasn't enough as the Mountain Hawks three-game win streak came to an end. Saint Joseph's began the game on an 11-4 run and took a 35-24 lead into halftime. Lehigh got to within four in the final minutes, but would not get any closer.

**LAST TIME OUT**

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - Senior Marquis Hall netted a game-high 17 points, while junior Michael Ojo equaled his career-high with 14 points as Lehigh returned to action on Thursday evening by snapping its three game losing streak with a 66-58 victory over Dartmouth at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks showed signs of having been off for 12 days for final exams but were able to come out with the victory - their fifth straight over the Big Green. Freshman Gabe Knutson pulled down a season best ten rebounds while senior Zahir Carrington returned to action after being out with an injury, and responded with eight points, five rebounds and a career best six blocked shots.

**DEFENSE PAVES THE WAY**

In their win on Thursday the Mountain Hawks held Dartmouth to only 58 points - the fewest by a Lehigh opponent this season. In its four wins Lehigh is holding teams to an average of 67.5 points on 41% shooting, but in their five losses the Mountain Hawks have allowed an average of 77.2 points on 47% shooting. Four of the teams that have beaten Lehigh scored at least 71 points.

**OUT-BATTLED ON THE BOARDS**

Lehigh led the Patriot League in rebounding a season ago, pulling down 39.6 boards per game and the Mountain Hawks' +3.0 rebound margin ranked second in the league. This year Lehigh is averaging 34.6 rebounds per game and sporting a -4.0 rebound margin. The Brown and White has already been out-rebounded in seven of its nine games after being out-rebounded just nine times all of last season.

**GROWING UP FAST**

Freshman Gabe Knutson has started every game for Lehigh during the early going of his career. The Iowa native has led Lehigh in rebounds in five games, including a season best 10 vs. Dartmouth, and he currently leads the team with a 6.6 per game average. In his last three games Knutson's offense has come to life as he has averaged 10.7 points on 11-of-21 shooting (52%), to go with a 10-11 showing at the foul line.

**INSTANT OFFENSE**

Juniors Rob Keefer and Michael Ojo have given Lehigh an instant lift off the bench this season as the pair is averaging 13.8 points between them with a combined seven double digit scoring games. Keefer netted 11 points in 15 minutes at Dayton on December 5 while Ojo tied his career high with 14 points in the win over Dartmouth on Thursday.

**HANDLING WITH CARE**

Lehigh committed a season low seven turnovers vs. Dartmouth, dropping the Mountain Hawks season average to only 13.7 per game. Lehigh has posted three games of single digit TOs this season and has won all three (Monmouth, St. Francis, Dartmouth).

**FINDING HIS GROOVE**

Senior captain Marquis Hall is beginning to find his offensive game. After averaging 9.0 points on 36% shooting in the first six games of the season the Oregon native has hit for 14.0 points on 47% shooting in his last three, including a season best 19 at Columbia. Earlier this week Hall was named a nominee for the 2010 Bob Cousy Award, given annually to the top collegiate male point guard. This marks the second consecutive season in which Hall has been up for the award.

**SCOUTING THE HAWKS...**

Head coach Phil Martelli is in his 15th season as the leader of the Saint Joseph's program ... the Hawks are being out-rebounded on average by 8.1 boards per game ... Saint Joseph's gave up 90+ points in its last two games, marking the first time that has happened since the 2001-02 season ... the Hawks are 7-3 in the first game after the break for final exams in the last ten years under Phil Martelli ... Lehigh and Saint Joseph's will take on four common opponents this season, including Holy Cross, Rider, Dayton and Richmond.

**CARRINGTON CLOSE TO HISTORY**

Senior Zahir Carrington is closing in on the 1,000-point and 500-rebound plateaus for his career. The Philadelphia native enters tonight's game with 969 career points, 31 shy of 1,000. Carrington will become the 28th member of Lehigh's 1,000-point club with his classmate Marquis Hall the latest entry into the club. Carrington is also just five rebounds shy of the 500 mark.

**ASSISTED WINS**

In their four wins this season the Mountain Hawks have totaled more assists than turnovers in each game, averaging 19 assists to just 10 TOs. In its five losses however, Lehigh has registered more assists than turnovers just once (Rider). The Mountain Hawks are averaging 17 turnovers and 14 assists in their five setbacks.

**REJECTED!**

Lehigh blocked a season best seven shots in the win over Dartmouth, led by Zahir Carrington's career high six rejections. The seven blocks were the Mountain Hawks most since swatting ten on November 28, 2007 vs. Quinnipiac.

**DON'T WE KNOW YOU?**

Lehigh faces a familiar foe this evening in Saint Joseph's center Todd O'Brien, a sophomore who transferred from Bucknell University. During the 2007-08 season O'Brien faced Lehigh twice as a member of the Bison, totaling 15 points on 7-of-15 shooting to go along with 13 rebounds. The Mountain Hawks won both games.

**UP NEXT...**

Lehigh returns home for its final game before taking a break for the holidays as the Mountain Hawks host Marist on Tuesday evening. Tip-off on December 22 from Stabler Arena is set for 7:05.

**THE NEXT CROP OF MOUNTAIN HAWKS**

Head coach Brett Reed has announced the Lehigh basketball class of 2014. The three newest Mountain Hawks will arrive on campus in the fall of 2010. They include:

*Anthony D'Orazio:* 6-2 guard from Camden Catholic High School (N.J.) ... as a junior, averaged 14.7 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists, while shooting 47% from the floor ... First-Team Olympic Conference and was named the MVP of the Olympic Cape Challenge and the Prime Time Shootout.

*Mackey McKnight:* 6-0 point guard from Langham Creek High School (Texas) ... as a junior, averaged 14.6 points, 6.8 assists and 4.3 rebounds per game while shooting 40% from three-point range ... District MVP Runner Up and First-Team All-District honors ... also named to the All-Regional Team.

*Kevin McCarthy:* 6-9 center who graduated from De La Salle Collegiate High School (Mich.) and is currently attending Philips Exeter Academy (N.H.) ... averaged 10.2 points, 8.2 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game last season ... First-Team All-District and All-League and Second-Team All-State.

**HITTING THE BOOKS**

During the 2009 spring semester, four Mountain Hawks achieved a grade point average of 3.2 or better. The list included Dave Buchberger (3.58), Marquis Hall (3.23), Rob Keefer (3.21) and Matt Szalachowski '09 (3.50). Hall was also named the 2009 Patriot League Men's Basketball Scholar Athlete of the Year - the first time a Lehigh men's basketball student-athlete earned this award.

**COAST TO COAST**

This year's Mountain Hawk roster is comprised of student-athletes that hail from ten different states. There is one player each from Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, New Jersey, New York, and Oregon, two players from Washington and Ohio, and three players from California and Pennsylvania.

Marquis Hall is a candidate for the 2009-10 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, presented annually to an NCAA Division I student-athlete in nine sports. Hall is one of 60 basketball players from around the country who was chosen (30 male and 30 female).
