SETTING THE SCENE

2010 Patriot League regular season champion Lehigh opens postseason play this evening as the top-seeded Mountain Hawks play host to No. 8 Army at Stabler Arena in the quarterfinal round of the Patriot League Tournament. Lehigh won both of its games last week, including an entertaining 91-80 victory over Holy Cross on Saturday. 2010 Patriot League Player and Rookie of the Year C.J. McCollum netted 28 points in the win, while senior captain Marquis Hall scored a season best 25 points, while handing out a career-high 12 assists. Army has dropped two straight, including a 62-51 loss to Bucknell at home this past weekend. Tonight's game is the fourth straight meeting between Lehigh and Army in the quarterfinals with the Black Knights having won the previous three.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won 70-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach in 2006-07.

IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will snap a four-game losing streak in the Patriot League Tournament, which includes three straight losses versus Army.
- The Mountain Hawks will advance to the semifinals of the Patriot League Tournament for the first time since 2006.
- Lehigh will win 20 games for only the third time in school history and the first time since the 2003-04 season.

LAST YEAR IN THE TOURNAMENT:

No. 5 LEHIGH AT NO. 4 ARMY (Christl Arena - 3/4/09)

WEST POINT, N.Y. - For the third straight year a Lehigh - Army Patriot League Tournament game went down to the final seconds, but a 12-point second half deficit for the Mountain Hawks was too much to overcome, as the host Black Knights held on for a 53-50 win at Christl Arena. The Mountain Hawks crept within a point on two separate occasions and had the basketball down by three with 25 seconds remaining, but junior Marquis Hall misfired on a pair of three-point attempts, and sophomore Rob Keefer's attempt at a buzzer-beating, game-tying three hit the front of the rim. Junior Zahir Carrington led the Mountain Hawks recording his tenth double-double of the season with 14 points and 13 rebounds, while freshman John Adams also registered a double-double in his first career start, totaling 12 points and grabbing 11 caroms. Lehigh shot only 29 percent from the field and connected on just 1-of-17 three-point attempts. The Mountain Hawks were unable to capitalize on a 45-29 rebounding advantage against the Black Knights, who shot 42 percent from the field for the game. Both teams struggled offensively out of the game, but for the Mountain Hawks their first half shooting woes continued for the full 20 minutes. Lehigh shot just 22 percent from the field in the opening half, including an 0-for-8 effort from beyond the arc.

TONIGHT'S GAME

Lehigh meets Army for the 91st time this evening with the Black Knights leading the series 59-31. Lehigh won both meetings earlier this season but Army has defeated the Mountain Hawks in each of the last three seasons in the quarterfinal round of the Patriot League Tournament.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

BETHLEHEM, Pa. (2/13/10) - C.J. McCollum became the first freshman in Lehigh history to score 25 or more points in five games as he netted a season-high 33 points to lift the Mountain Hawks to a 78-66 victory over Army at Stabler Arena. Senior captain Marquis Hall added 14 points and eight assists in what was Lehigh's eighth straight regular season victory over the Black Knights at Stabler Arena. Lehigh wound up shooting 53% for the game and held Army to a 40% showing. Jeremy Hence came off the bench to lead the Black Knights with 14 points.

LAST TIME OUT

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - Behind a torrid shooting performance Lehigh earned its first outright Patriot League championship in school history with a 91-80 victory over Holy Cross at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks buried a Stabler Arena record 15 three-pointers and shot 54% from the field in winning their first league title since 2004 and the first outright title in school annals. Freshman C.J. McCollum knocked down five three-pointers en route to a game-high 28 points, while senior captain Marquis Hall drained six three-pointers and scored a season best 25 points to go along with a career-high 12 assists. Holy Cross was led by Andrew Beinert's 21 points.

OFFENSIVE JUGGERNAUT

Lehigh leads the Patriot League in scoring offense at 75.4 points per game. **For the first time in school annals, Lehigh has scored 70+ points in 18 straight games, including a season-best 91 at Colgate on February 17.** The Mountain Hawks also rank first in the league in scoring margin (+3.7), and three-point percentage (38.9) and are second in field goal percentage (45.2).

HALL CLAIMS TOP SPOT

Senior captain Marquis Hall became Lehigh's single season assist record holder with his career-high 12 helpers in the win over Holy Cross. Hall has 165 assists this season, which broke the mark of 160 set by Mike McKee during the 1993-94 season. Hall is number one in school history and second in Patriot League annals with 544 career assists. His 5.7 per game lead the P.L. this season, while Lehigh also paces the league at 15.2 per contest.

STRONG AT THE STAR

In 14 home games Lehigh is averaging 76.1 points on 46% shooting, while holding teams to 67.9 points on 40% shooting. The Mountain Hawks are also out-rebounding foes by 1.9 per contest and hold a +1.4 turnover margin. **A win this evening would give Lehigh 13 victories at the STAR for the only the second time in school history (2003-04).**

MCCOLLUM MAKES HISTORY; FOUR HONORED BY LEAGUE

C.J. McCollum made history on Monday as he became the first men's basketball player in Patriot League history to be named the league's Player and Rookie of the Year. McCollum was also named to the All-League First-Team as well as the All-Rookie Team. Joining McCollum on the All-League Teams were senior captains Marquis Hall and Zahir Carrington who garnered Second-Team distinction, while freshman Gabe Knutson joined McCollum on the All-Rookie Team. This is Hall's third straight selection to the All-League Teams and Carrington's second consecutive.

MORE ON MCCOLLUM

With his selection as the league's Rookie of the Week on Monday, C.J. McCollum became only the third player in league history to earn nine Rookie awards, joining teammate Marquis Hall (2006-07) and Bucknell's Kevin Bettencourt (2002-03). McCollum leads all freshmen nationally with an 18.8 points per game average and his 544 points are the most-ever by a freshman in league annals. McCollum needs three more points to become Lehigh's all-time leading freshman scorer; Daren Queenan '88 currently holds the top spot with 546 tallies during the 1984-85 season.

HALL EARNS SECOND STRAIGHT SCHOLAR ATHLETE AWARD

For the second consecutive year Marquis Hall was named the Patriot League Men's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year, it was announced on Monday. Hall carries a 3.39 grade point average as a Finance major and has been named to the Dean's List and Patriot League Academic Honor Roll on multiple occasions. He is a two time nominee for the Bob Cousy Award and one of only ten national finalists for the 2010 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, which combines achievement in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition.

SCOUTING THE BLACK KNIGHTS ...

Head coach Zach Spiker is in his first season as the leader of the Army program ... the Black Knights lead the Patriot League in scoring defense (60.9) and field goal percentage defense (.408) ... Cleveland Richard is second in the league in steals, averaging 1.8 per game ... Army has not scored more than 70 points since its opening game vs. VMI.

WHAT'S BEEN THE PROBLEM?

Lehigh looks to snap a four game losing streak in the P.L. Tournament this evening, with the last three losses coming to Army. In those four setbacks Lehigh has shot 33% (75-288), including an 11% showing from three-point range (7-61) and scored 55.8 points per game. The Mountain Hawks' most points in that time was 66 at Holy Cross in the 2006 semifinals.

NEARING THE TOP

Lehigh's 19 wins this season are tied for the third most in school history. The Mountain Hawks can climb into a tie for second with a win here this evening.

THE 500 CLUB

C.J. McCollum is the first Lehigh player to score 500 points in a single season since Jose Olivero accomplished the feat in 2006-07. McCollum needs 39 more points to move into the top-five for single season scoring at Lehigh.

FROM DOWNTOWN

Lehigh currently ranks 14th in the nation in three-point shooting at 39.8%. The Mountain Hawks, who have shot 40% or better in 16 games, have made 195 three-pointers this season. **Lehigh needs to make four more to break the school record of 198 trifectas, set by the 2003-04 squad.**

With a win this evening Lehigh will advance to the semifinal round of the P.L. Tournament. The Mountain Hawks would host the winner of the American - Navy quarterfinal matchup here at Stabler Arena on Sunday, March 7 beginning at 8:00 PM.

NON-LEAGUE SUCCESS

With its win vs. Yale on January 5 Lehigh earned its ninth win of the season. The Mountain Hawks' 19 non-league victories over the course of the past two seasons are their most in a two-year span since the inception of the Patriot League.

HE'S A SHINING STAR AT STABLER

Lehigh head coach Brett Reed is 31-12 at Stabler Arena during his two-plus years at the helm. Reed's win percentage of 72% at the STAR ranks third all-time in school annals behind Billy Taylor (76%) and Fran McCaffery (73%).
