#### SETTING THE SCENE

A spot in the Patriot League championship game is on the line this evening as top-seeded Lehigh meets No. 4 American in the semifinals of the 2010 Patriot League Tournament at Stabler Arena. Lehigh downed its first round opponent, No. 8 Army, by a score of 64-45 on Wednesday at home in a game in which the Mountain Hawks outscored the Black Knights 46-25 after halftime. 2010 Patriot League Player and Rookie of the Year C.J. McCollum netted 17 of his game-high 19 points in the second half and was joined in double digits by Michael Ojo (13), Zahir Carrington (12) and Marquis Hall (10). American defeated the fifth seeded Navy Midshipmen at home by a score of 62-60 on Wednesday as the Eagles won their ninth consecutive quarterfinal game in the P.L. Tournament. Stephen Lumpkins led AU with a career-high 29 points and 15 rebounds. These teams have not met in the postseason since the 2004 Patriot League championship game.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won 70-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach in 2006-07.

#### IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will advance to the Patriot League championship game for the first time since 2004 and only the second time ever.
- The Mountain Hawks will tie the school record for victories in a single season with 21.
- Lehigh will win its 14th game at Stabler Arena, which would be a school record.

**TONIGHT'S GAME**

Lehigh meets American for the 33rd time this afternoon with the Eagles leading the series 18-14. The Mountain Hawks won both meetings this year, including last month's matchup at Bender Arena. These teams have not met in the Patriot League Tournament since 2004.

**THE LAST TIME THEY MET**

WASHINGTON, D.C. (2/6/10) - Lehigh snapped American's 20-game Patriot League home win streak with a 77-65 victory over the Eagles at Bender Arena in the nation's capital. Four Mountain Hawks scored in double figures led by senior Zahir Carrington with 20 points, while freshman C.J. McCollum recorded his first career double-double with 19 points and a career-best 13 rebounds. Lehigh wound up shooting 44% for the game, which included a strong 52% showing in the final 20 minutes. Joining Carrington and McCollum in double figures were senior Marquis Hall with 18 and freshman Gabe Knutson with ten. Lehigh out-rebounded the Eagles 35-30 and scored 15 points off 14 AU turnovers.

**LAST TIME OUT**

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - After scoring only 18 points in the first half, Lehigh's offense got in gear and outscored Army 46-25 in the final 20 minutes as the top-seeded Mountain Hawks outlasted No. 8 Army 64-45 in the quarterfinal round of the 2010 P.L. tourney at Stabler Arena. With the win Lehigh snapped a four-game losing streak in the P.L. Tournament and advanced to the semifinals for the first time since 2006. Patriot League Player and Rookie of the Year C.J. McCollum scored 17 of his game-high 19 points after halftime, while Michael Ojo (13), Zahir Carrington (12) and Marquis Hall (10) also scored in double digits.

**ON LOCK DOWN**

Lehigh held Army to 45 points in the quarterfinal round on Wednesday, which were the fewest points the Mountain Hawks have allowed since Colgate scored 40 on February 18, 2009. The 45 points were also the fewest Lehigh has allowed in the postseason since Colgate scored 44 in the 2006 quarterfinals in Worcester, Massachusetts. The Mountain Hawks are currently second in the league in field goal percentage defense (42.5%).

**STRONG AT THE STAR**

In 15 home games Lehigh is averaging 75.3 points on 46% shooting, while holding teams to 66.4 points on 40% shooting. The Mountain Hawks are also out-rebounding foes by 2.2 per contest and hold a +1.5 turnover margin. **A win this evening would give Lehigh 14 victories at the STAR for the first time in school history.**

**SCORING STREAK COMES TO A CLOSE**

Lehigh saw its school record 18 game streak of 70+ points come to a close on Wednesday vs. Army. Prior to that game the last time the Mountain Hawks had scored fewer than 70 points was December 22 when they scored 66 vs. Marist. Lehigh still ranks first in the league in scoring offense (75.0), scoring margin (+4.2), and three-point percentage (39.6) and are second in field goal percentage (45.5).

**ALL-AMERICAN EFFORT**

In his last four games vs American Zahir Carrington has averaged 19.3 points and 9.3 rebounds on 55% shooting. The senior has posted three double-doubles in that time.

**MCCOLLUM MAKES HISTORY; FOUR HONORED BY LEAGUE**

C.J. McCollum made history when he became the first men's basketball player in Patriot League history to be named the league's Player and Rookie of the Year. McCollum was also named to the All-League First-Team as well as the All-Rookie Team. Joining McCollum on the All-League Teams were Marquis Hall and Zahir Carrington who garnered Second-Team distinction, and Gabe Knutson who joined McCollum on the Rookie Team.

**MORE ON MCCOLLUM**

With his selection as the league's Rookie of the Week on March 1, C.J. McCollum became only the third player in league history to earn nine Rookie awards, joining teammate Marquis Hall (2006-07) and Bucknell's Kevin Bettencourt (2002-03). McCollum leads all freshmen nationally with an 18.8 points per game average and his 563 points are the most-ever by a freshman in Patriot League and Lehigh history.

**DOWN TO THE WIRE**

Dating back to the 2004 Patriot League championship game, the last seven games played between Lehigh and American inside of Stabler Arena have been decided by only 7.4 points. The Mountain Hawks are 4-3 in those contests with five of the games decided by fewer than ten points.

**SCOUTING THE EAGLES...**

Head coach Jeff Jones is in his tenth season as the leader of the American program ... Vlad Moldoveanu was named to the All-Patriot League First Team after averaging 20.4 points per game during league action ... since 2002 American has appeared in the league championship game on five occasions, winning the title twice ... the Eagles are 4-11 away from home this season, and won just twice away from home during the P.L. slate ... American is forcing only 9.6 turnovers per game this season.

**LIGHTS OUT**

The Mountain Hawks improved their record to 8-0 when shooting above 50% in the win over Army. **Lehigh, which shot 55% against the Black Knights has won 16 straight games when shooting above 50% with the last loss coming at Notre Dame on November 27, 2006.**

**THE 500 CLUB**

C.J. McCollum is the first Lehigh player to score 500 points in a single season since Jose Olivero accomplished the feat in 2006-07. McCollum needs 39 more points to move into the top-five for single season scoring at Lehigh.

**FROM DOWNTOWN**

Lehigh currently ranks 14th in the nation in three-point shooting at 39.6%. The Mountain Hawks, who have shot 40% or better in 16 games, have made 198 three-pointers this season. **Lehigh needs to make just one more to break the school record of 198 trifectas, set by the 2003-04 squad.**

**UP NEXT...**

With a win this evening Lehigh will advance to its first Patriot League championship game since 2004 when the Mountain Hawks won their first-ever title. The championship game would take place here at Stabler Arena beginning at 4:45 on Friday, March 12.
