#### SETTING THE SCENE

First place in the Patriot League and the inside track for the top seed in the upcoming postseason tournament are on the line this evening as Lehigh hosts the Bucknell Bison at Stabler Arena. Lehigh saw its two game win streak come to an end on Sunday afternoon as the Mountain Hawks were done in by Lafayette's torrid shooting in a 90-75 loss in Easton. Freshman sensation C.J. McCollum did his part, leading the Brown and White in points (28), rebounds (10), assists (6) and steals (4), but it was not enough to overcome a 16-of-29 shooting performance by the Leopards from three-point range. Bucknell enters tonight's contest as the hottest team in the Patriot League as the Bison have won four straight games and seven of eight after rolling past Colgate 69-49 on Sunday at home.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won 70-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach in 2006-07.

#### IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will be alone in first place in the Patriot League with a shot at winning the regular season championship outright in its next game.
- The Mountain Hawks will defeat Bucknell for the third straight time inside Stabler Arena. Lehigh won five straight versus the Bison at home from 2001 through 2005.
- Lehigh will notch win number 18; it would mark the sixth 18-win season in school annals.

## TONIGHT'S GAME

Lehigh and Bucknell meet for the 152nd time this evening with the Bison leading the series 91-60. The Mountain Hawks have dropped two straight overall, including last month's contest in Lewisburg, but Lehigh has defeated Bucknell in each of the last two meetings inside of Stabler Arena.

### THE LAST TIME THEY MET

LEWISBURG, Pa. (1/27/10) - Lehigh saw a ten-point lead with 3:22 remaining in regulation evaporate and the Mountain Hawks were eventually outlasted 81-76 in overtime by the Bucknell Bison at Sojka Pavilion. Lehigh had one last shot in regulation to try and win the game, but senior Marquis Hall's three-point attempt rimmed out and the teams headed for the extra session where the Bison outscored the Brown and White 14-9. Hall led Lehigh with a season-high 21 points, while freshman C.J. McCollum added 20 but it was not enough. Joining Hall and McCollum in double figures for Lehigh were Zahir Carrington (14) and Gabe Knutson (13).

### LAST TIME OUT

EASTON, Pa. - Lafayette connected on 16-of-29 three-pointers and shot 59% overall as the Leopards downed Lehigh 90-75 at Kirby Sports Center. C.J. McCollum recorded his third double-double of the season with 28 points and 10 rebounds but it was not enough as the Mountain Hawks fell into a first place tie in the Patriot League with Bucknell. Lafayette was led on offense by Ryan Willen who scored 22 points. After Lehigh began the game on a 10-2 run the Leopards scored 18 of the next 22 points to go in front 20-15. Lafayette led 47-41 at halftime and unleashed a 17-4 run early in the second half to break the game open.

## THERE'S NO "D" IN THESE LOSSES

In its four league losses Lehigh has allowed teams to score an incredible 87.5 points on 48% shooting overall and 41% from beyond the arc. All four teams scored at least 81 points. In their eight league wins however, the Mountain Hawks have held their opponents to 63.9 points on 39% shooting from the field and 30% from downtown. Only once has a team scored more than 67 points during that time (Colgate - 81).

## THE POINTS KEEP ON COMING

During its last 16 games Lehigh is averaging 78.7 points on 47.4% shooting. **It marks the first time in school history that Lehigh has scored 70+ points in 16 straight games.** Lehigh, which scored a season-best 91 points in the win at Colgate on February 17, currently leads the Patriot League in scoring offense at 74.6 points per contest.

## HALL LOOKING TO PASS TOP SPOT

Senior captain Marquis Hall is already Lehigh's all-time assists leader and now the Oregon native has his eyes set on the single season assist record. **Hall has dished out 153 helpers this season, which are the second most in one season in school annals. Hall needs eight more assists to break the record of 160 set by Mike McKee during the 1993-94 season.** With Hall leading the way the Mountain Hawks pace the P.L. in assists averaging 15.0 per game.

## STRONG AT THE STAR

In 12 home games Lehigh is averaging 74.4 points on 45% shooting, while holding teams to 67.7 points on 39% shooting. The Mountain Hawks are also out-rebounding foes by 1.5 per contest and hold a +1.6 turnover margin. Lehigh's ten wins at the STAR are tied for the third most in Stabler Arena history.

## THE KID CAN PLAY

C.J. McCollum is having quite a remarkable season for the Mountain Hawks as he leads all freshmen nationally in scoring and leads the P.L. during league play with a 22.7 points per game average. An eight-time Rookie of the Week honoree, McCollum is the first Lehigh freshman to post six games of 25+ points and his 487 points are the second most by a freshman in school history behind only Daren Queenan '88, the school's all-time leading scorer. McCollum is also just 23 points shy of eclipsing Adonal Foyle's league mark for scoring by a freshman. Foyle scored 509 points during the 1994-95 campaign.

## THE X FACTOR?

In Lehigh's eight league wins, senior Dave Buchberger has averaged 7.4 points on 42% shooting overall and 46% from three-point range. In the four league losses however, Buchberger has shot just 23% from the floor, including 22% from downtown, and averaged 2.0 points. He has gone scoreless in two of those contests, both coming versus Navy.

## SCOUTING THE BISON...

Head coach Dave Paulsen is in his second season as the leader of the Bucknell program ... the Bison are second in the league in free throw percentage (.737), but last in field goal percentage (.412) ... Mike Muscala is the league leader in blocked shots, averaging 2.1 per contest ... like Lehigh, Bucknell has already clinched a home game in the quarterfinal round of the upcoming Patriot League Tournament ... during league play Bucknell is holding teams to 65.3 points and a league leading 41.9% mark from the floor.

**POINTS AT A PREMIUM**

In Bucknell's last five trips to Stabler Arena the Mountain Hawks have held the Bison to an average of 56.0 points per game. Bucknell has not scored more than 69 points in any of those contests and three of the games have been decided by five points or fewer.

**LOOKING TO FINISH STRONG**

Dating back to the 1998-99 season Lehigh is a combined 3-19 during the final week of the regular season. The Mountain Hawks have won back-to-back games during the final week of the regular season just twice since the inception of Patriot League play in 1990. Lehigh accomplished the feat in 1991 and again in 2008.

**FROM DOWNTOWN**

Lehigh currently leads the Patriot League and ranks 24th in the nation in three-point shooting at 38.6%. The Mountain Hawks, who have shot 40% or better in 14 games, have made 173 three-pointers this season. They need to make 26 more to break the school record of 198 trifectas, set by the 2003-04 league championship squad.

**BOARDING SCHOOL**

In their first nine games of the season the Mountain Hawks were out-rebounded by 4.0 boards per game, but in the last 18 games Lehigh is sporting a +3.6 rebound margin and has out-rebounded 14 of those foes. The Mountain Hawks are currently second in the Patriot League in total rebounds at 37.1 per game and their 26.6 defensive boards per game is tops in the P.L.

**UP NEXT...**

Lehigh closes out the regular season on Saturday evening when the Mountain Hawks play host to Holy Cross on Senior Night. Tip-off on February 27 is set for 7:35 from the STAR.

## NON-LEAGUE SUCCESS

With its win vs. Yale on January 5 Lehigh earned its ninth win of the season. The Mountain Hawks' 19 non-league victories over the course of the past two seasons are their most in a two-year span since the inception of the Patriot League.

## HE'S A SHINING STAR AT STABLER

Lehigh head coach Brett Reed is 29-12 at Stabler Arena during his two-plus years at the helm. Reed's win percentage of 71% at the STAR ranks third all-time in school annals behind Billy Taylor (76%) and Fran McCaffery (73%).

## MARCHING TO THE LINE

The Mountain Hawks have shot 131 more free throws and made 93 more than their opponents this season. Lehigh, which is shooting 71% at the stripe, has attempted more free throws than its opponent in 18 games, including a season best 40 vs. NJIT.

## HALFWAY THERE

Under Brett Reed, the Mountain Hawks are 31-5 when leading at the break, and just 12-28 when trailing at intermission.

## MEN OF STEAL

In their game at Saint Joseph's the Mountain Hawks recorded a season-high 11 steals, including a career-best five thefts by senior captain Marquis Hall. The 11 steals were Lehigh's most since totaling 13 in the opener at Saint Peter's last season (Nov, 2008).

## BALANCED ATTACK

In 29 games a season ago Lehigh was led in scoring by five different players and in rebounding by six. This season, seven Mountain Hawks have led the squad in scoring and eight Mountain Hawks have led the team in rebounds.

### HALL NAMED A FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

Marquis Hall is one of ten male finalists for the 2009-10 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, presented annually to an NCAA Division I student-athlete in nine sports. The ten finalists were chosen from a group of 30 men's basketball players from around the country with the winner to be announced during the Final Four. ### BAILEY TO JOIN LEHIGH IN 2011

**B.J. Bailey, a 6-2 guard out of Mays Landing, N.J. (Holy Spirit High School)**, has transferred to Lehigh from Boston University. Bailey appeared in six games this season for the BU Terriers. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Bailey will sit out the 2010 spring and fall semesters and be eligible to play beginning with the 2011 spring semester.

### THE NEXT CROP OF MOUNTAIN HAWKS

Head coach Brett Reed has announced the Lehigh basketball class of 2014. It includes:

**Anthony D'Orazio:** 6-2 guard from Camden Catholic High School (N.J.) ... as a junior, averaged 14.7 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists, while shooting 47% from the floor ... First-Team Olympic Conference and was named the MVP of the Olympic Cape Challenge and the Prime Time Shootout.

**Mackey McKnight:** 6-0 point guard from Langham Creek High School (Texas) ... as a junior, averaged 14.6 points, 6.8 assists and 4.3 rebounds per game while shooting 40% from three-point range ... District MVP Runner Up and First-Team All-District honors ... also named to the All-Regional Team.

**Kevin McCarthy:** 6-9 center who graduated from De La Salle Collegiate High School (Mich.) and is currently attending Philips Exeter Academy (N.H.) ... averaged 10.2 points, 8.2 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game last season ... First-Team All-District and All-League and Second-Team All-State.
