SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh looks to bounce back from a tough loss its last time out when the Mountain Hawks play host to the Army Black Knights this evening at Stabler Arena. Lehigh fell to Navy on Wednesday by a score of 85-78 as Chris Harris scored a career-best 40 points for the Midshipmen. Freshman C.J. McCollum (27 points, 10 rebounds) and senior Zahir Carrington (15 points, 10 rebounds) did their best to keep the Mountain Hawks in it, but Navy sank 14 three-pointers and 21-of-27 foul shots to hold on for the road win. The loss snapped Lehigh's seven-game home win streak that dated back to mid-December. Army meanwhile has lost four of its last five games, including a 76-50 setback to Holy Cross on Wednesday in West Point. Cleveland Richard was the lone Black Knight to score in double figures with 15 points but Army shot only 37% as a team, while the Crusaders connected on 52% of their attempts and placed four players in double digits.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won 70-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach in 2006-07.

IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will surpass its win total from all of last season.
- The Mountain Hawks will maintain at least a share of first place in the Patriot League.
- Lehigh will defeat Army for the eighth straight time at Stabler Arena during the regular season.

TONIGHT'S GAME

Lehigh meets Army for the 90th time this evening with the Black Knights leading the series 59-30. Lehigh has won seven straight regular season meetings versus Army here at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks also won last month's matchup in West Point.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

WEST POINT, N.Y. (1/17/10) - Four Lehigh players scored in double figures and the Mountain Hawks held Army to 33% shooting as the Brown and White downed the Black Knights 73-55 at Christl Arena. Senior Zahir Carrington led the Mountain Hawks with a season best 20 points, while fellow seniors Marquis Hall and Dave Buchberger added 15 and 12, respectively, and freshman C.J. McCollum scored 13. Cleveland Richard was the lone Black Knight in double figures with 11. Army closed to within ten at 54-44, but Lehigh ripped off ten straight points in a matter of 3:03 to go up 64-44 and the Brown and White never looked back from there.

LAST TIME OUT

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - Navy's Chris Harris exploded for 40 points and the Midshipmen snapped Lehigh's seven-game win streak at Stabler Arena with an 85-78 victory over the Mountain Hawks on Wednesday evening. Freshman C.J. McCollum notched his second straight double-double with 27 points and 10 rebounds, while senior Zahir Carrington also recorded a double-double with 15 points and ten boards but it was not enough as the Brown and White fell into a first place tie in the Patriot League with Navy. Gabe Knutson also scored in double figures for Lehigh, adding 11 points, while senior Marquis Hall dished out a team-best eight assists on the night.

MOUNTAIN HAWKS ESTABLISH NEW SCORING MARK

During its last 13 games Lehigh is averaging 78.1 points on 46.7% shooting. **It marks the first time in school history that Lehigh has scored 70+ points in 13 straight games.** Lehigh, which scored a season-best 89 points in its win at Longwood, currently leads the Patriot League in scoring offense at 73.8 points per contest.

HALL LOOKING TO PASS TOP SPOT

Senior captain Marquis Hall is already Lehigh's all-time assists leader and now the Oregon native has his eyes set on the single season assist record. Hall has dished out 139 helpers this season, which are the third most in one season in school annals. Hall needs 21 more assists to break the record of 160 set by Mike McKee during the 1993-94 season. With Hall leading the way the Mountain Hawks lead the P.L. in assists averaging 14.8 per game.

MIGHTY MCCOLLUM

C.J. McCollum continues to fill it up with 13 straight games of double digit points and a 21.0 per game average during Patriot League play. McCollum, who has been named the Patriot League Rookie of the Week on six different occasions, is the first Lehigh freshman to post four games of 25+ points since the school's all-time leading scorer Daren Queenan '88, did it during the 1984-1985 season. McCollum's 404 points are already the second most by a freshman in school history.

STABLER SETBACKS

In their two losses at Stabler Arena this season the Mountain Hawks have allowed averages of 78.0 points and 11.5 three-pointers. Lehigh has also been outscored a combined 90-60 in the first half. In their nine wins at the STAR the Mountain Hawks have allowed averages of 65.6 points and 5.7 three-pointers, while outscoring the opposition 306-257 in the opening half.

80 IS NOT THE MAGIC NUMBER

Lehigh fell to 0-5 this season when allowing 80 or more points with its loss on Wednesday. The last time the Mountain Hawks allowed 80 or more points and still won was January 17, 2001. Lehigh defeated Army 89-81 that day.

CARRINGTON CAN'T BE STOPPED

In his last seven games versus Army, senior captain Zahir Carrington has averaged 16.3 points on 56.7% shooting (42-74) as well as 7.0 rebounds. During that time the Philadelphia native has posted two double-doubles, one of which came in last year's victory at Stabler Arena.

SCOUTING THE BLACK KNIGHTS...

Head coach Zach Spiker is in his first season as the leader of the Army program ... the Black Knights currently lead the Patriot League in scoring defense, allowing only 59.9 points per game and they also rank first in field goal percentage defense holding teams to 39.7% from the field ... Cleveland Richard leads the league in steals, averaging 1.8 per game and Josh Miller is Army's all-time steals leader with 144 ... Army has not scored more than 70 points since the season opener vs. VMI.

BOARD WORK

In their first nine games of the season the Mountain Hawks were out-rebounded by 4.0 boards per game, but in the last 15 games Lehigh is sporting a +3.4 rebound margin and has out-rebounded 11 of those foes. The Mountain Hawks are currently second in the Patriot League in total rebounds at 37.4 per game and their 27.3 defensive boards per game is tops in the P.L.

TIME TO BOUNCE BACK

Lehigh looks to get back in the win column this evening following a disappointing setback versus Navy. Lehigh has not lost two straight games since early December and the Mountain Hawks have not dropped consecutive games at Stabler Arena since January/February of 2009.

TURNING UP THE "D"

The Mountain Hawks lead the Patriot League during league play in field goal percentage defense (39%), three-point defense (30%) and scoring margin (+7.6) and have held six of nine opponents under 70 points. During non-league play Lehigh allowed teams to shoot 43% from the field and 37% from downtown.

BENCH HELP

In the game versus Navy on Wednesday Lehigh's bench scored 17 points led by freshman Holden Greiner's eight-point effort on three-of-five shooting. The 17 bench points were the Mountain Hawks' most since totaling 17 at Navy in mid-January.

UP NEXT...

Lehigh heads to New York to face the Colgate Raiders on Wednesday evening. The Mountain Hawks and Raiders tip things off at 7:00 on February 17 in Hamilton.

NON-LEAGUE SUCCESS

With its win vs. Yale on January 5 Lehigh earned its ninth win of the season. The Mountain Hawks' 19 non-league victories over the course of the past two seasons are their most in a two-year span since the inception of the Patriot League.

HE'S A SHINING STAR AT STABLER

Lehigh head coach Brett Reed is 28-12 at Stabler Arena during his two-plus years at the helm. Reed's win percentage of 70% at the STAR ranks third all-time in school annals behind Billy Taylor (76%) and Fran McCaffery (73%).

STRONG AT THE STRIPE DOWN THE STRETCH

MARCHING TO THE LINE

The Mountain Hawks have shot 102 more free throws and made 76 more than their opponents this season. Lehigh, which is shooting 71% at the stripe, has attempted more free throws than its opponent in 15 games, including a season best 40 vs. NJIT.

HALFWAY THERE

Under Brett Reed, the Mountain Hawks are 30-5 when leading at the break, and just 11-27 when trailing at intermission.

MEN OF STEAL

In their game at Saint Joseph's the Mountain Hawks recorded a season-high 11 steals, including a career-best five thefts by senior captain Marquis Hall. The 11 steals were Lehigh's most since totaling 13 in the opener at Saint Peter's last season (Nov, 2008).

BALANCED ATTACK

In 29 games a season ago Lehigh was led in scoring by five different players and in rebounding by six. This season, seven Mountain Hawks have led the squad in scoring and eight Mountain Hawks have led the team in rebounds.

HALL NAMED A FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD

Marquis Hall is one of ten male finalists for the 2009-10 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, presented annually to an NCAA Division I student-athlete in nine sports. The ten finalists were chosen from a group of 30 men's basketball players from around the country with the winner to be announced during the Final Four. Based on criteria focusing on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition, the award winners will be selected by national balloting of head basketball coaches, national media and college basketball fans. *Lehigh fans can vote at: seniorclassaward.com. BAILEY TO JOIN LEHIGH IN 2011

B.J. Bailey, a 6-2 guard out of Mays Landing, N.J. (Holy Spirit High School), has transferred to Lehigh from Boston University. Bailey appeared in six games this season for the BU Terriers. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Bailey will sit out the 2010 spring and fall semesters and be eligible to play beginning with the 2011 spring semester.

Anthony D'Orazio: 6-2 guard from Camden Catholic High School (N.J.) ... as a junior, averaged 14.7 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists, while shooting 47% from the floor ... First-Team Olympic Conference and was named the MVP of the Olympic Cape Challenge and the Prime Time Shootout.

Mackey McKnight: 6-0 point guard from Langham Creek High School (Texas) ... as a junior, averaged 14.6 points, 6.8 assists and 4.3 rebounds per game while shooting 40% from three-point range ... District MVP Runner Up and First-Team All-District honors ... also named to the All-Regional Team.

Kevin McCarthy: 6-9 center who graduated from De La Salle Collegiate High School (Mich.) and is currently attending Philips Exeter Academy (N.H.) ... averaged 10.2 points, 8.2 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game last season ... First-Team All-District and All-League and Second-Team All-State.
