SETTING THE SCENE

For the first time since January 23 Lehigh will play a game at Stabler Arena as the Mountain Hawks welcome the Navy Midshipmen to town this evening. Lehigh is coming off a three-game road trip in which the Brown and White went 2-1, including a 77-65 victory over American this past weekend in Washington, D.C. Senior Zahir Carrington scored a team-high 20 points, while freshman C.J. McCollum notched his first career double-double with 19 points and a season best 13 rebounds as the Mountain Hawks took over sole possession of first place in the Patriot League. Navy has won three of its past four games, including an 81-79 decision over Bucknell on Friday evening in Annapolis. The Midshipmen were led by Romeo Garcia's career-high 20-point effort as four Navy players hit for double figures in the victory.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won over 70-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach in 2006-07.

IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will surpass its win total from all of last season.
- The Mountain Hawks will improve to 10-1 at Stabler Arena for the first time since the 2003-04 season.
- Lehigh will be off to its best start in Patriot League play since starting 8-1 during the 2005-06 season.

TONIGHT'S GAME

Lehigh and Navy meet for the 61st time this evening with the Midshipmen leading the series 43-17. Navy has won four of the past five meetings, including last month's matchup in Annapolis, and the Midshipmen have defeated the Mountain Hawks three straight times at Stabler Arena.

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (1/14/10) - Freshman C.J. McCollum tied his career-high with 31 points but it was not enough as Lehigh saw its six-game win streak come to an end with a 94-83 loss to Navy at Alumni Hall. McCollum sank 11-of-18 shots from the floor and six-of-eight at the line but the Midshipmen shot 87% from the free throw line and put up 58 second half points to earn the win. Along with McCollum freshman Gabe Knutson (16), senior Marquis Hall (10) and junior Michael Ojo (10) hit for double figures. Navy was led by Chris Harris' 29 tallies.

LAST TIME OUT

WASHINGTON, D.C. - Lehigh snapped American's 20-game home Patriot League win streak on Saturday afternoon with a 77-65 victory over the Eagles at Bender Arena in the nation's capital. Four Mountain Hawks scored in double figures led by senior Zahir Carrington with 20 points, while freshman C.J. McCollum recorded his first career double-double with 19 points and a career-best 13 rebounds. Lehigh wound up shooting 44% for the game, which included a strong 52% showing in the final 20 minutes. Joining Carrington and McCollum in double figures were senior Marquis Hall with 18 and freshman Gabe Knutson with 10. Lehigh out-rebounded the Eagles 35-30 and scored 15 points off 14 AU turnovers.

OFFENSE CONTINUES TO ROLL

During its last 12 games Lehigh is averaging 78.1 points on 47.1% shooting. **The last time Lehigh scored 70+ points in 12 consecutive games was the 1992-93 season. The Brown and White scored 70 or more points in 12 straight games that season.** Lehigh, which scored a season-best 89 points in its win at Longwood, currently leads the Patriot League in scoring offense at 73.6 points per contest.

HALL LOOKING TO PASS TOP SPOT

Senior captain Marquis Hall is already Lehigh's all-time assists leader and now the Oregon native has his eyes set on the single season assist record. Hall has dished out 131 helpers this season, which are the sixth most in one season in school annals. Hall needs 29 more assists to break the record of 160 set by Mike McKee during the 1993-94 season. With Hall leading the way the Mountain Hawks lead the P.L. in assists averaging 14.7 per game.

MIGHTY MCCOLLUM

C.J. McCollum continues to fill it up with 12 straight games of double digit points and a 20.3 per game average during Patriot League play. McCollum, who has been named the Patriot League Rookie of the Week on six different occasions, is the first Lehigh freshman to post three games of 25+ points since the school's all-time leading scorer Daren Queenan '88, did it during the 1984-1985 season. McCollum's 377 points are already the second most by a freshman in school history.

FROM DOWNTOWN

In seven league games Lehigh is shooting 41% from three-point range, with three games of 50% or better. The Mountain Hawks are also holding the opposition to a 27% showing from beyond the arc in those seven contests. During the non-league schedule the Mountain Hawks connected on 38% of their threes and allowed teams to hit 37%. Lehigh is currently 34th in America in three-point percentage at 38.6%.

HOME, SWEET HOME

Lehigh returns to Stabler Arena for the first time in three weeks this evening as the Mountain Hawks put their 9-1 home record on the line. Lehigh, which has won six straight games at the STAR, is averaging 73.7 points on 44% shooting while boasting a +2.0 turnover margin in ten home games this season. The Mountain Hawks are limiting teams to 66.1 points on 38% shooting from the floor and 29% from three during that time.

HANDLING WITH CARE

The Mountain Hawks continue to do a solid job of protecting the basketball as they tied their season low with only seven TOs at American. During Patriot League play Lehigh is averaging 11.6 turnovers per game while forcing 14.1; the Mountain Hawks lead the league in turnover margin at +2.5 during that time.

SCOUTING THE MIDSHIPMEN...

Head coach Billy Lange is in his sixth season as the leader of the Navy program ... Chris Harris currently leads the Patriot League in scoring ... the Midshipmen are only 2-8 on the road this season ... Lehigh and Navy are the top two scoring teams in the Patriot League during league play ... O.J. Avworo's 122 assists are the most by a Navy player since 1997 ... the Midshipmen have averaged 90.5 points in their last two games ... including tonight's contest, Navy will play four of its final six regular season games on the road.

MAKING POINTS OUT OF MISCUES

Lehigh has outscored its last two opponents by a staggering 40-13 margin in points off of turnovers. In four Patriot League road games the Mountain Hawks have outscored the opposition 89-60 in this category. In three home P.L. contests however, Lehigh has been outscored 46-37 in points off of TOs.

BOARD WORK

In their first nine games of the season the Mountain Hawks were out-rebounded by 4.0 boards per game, but in the last 14 games Lehigh is sporting a +2.6 rebound margin and has out-rebounded ten of those foes. The Mountain Hawks are currently second in the Patriot League in total rebounds at 37.0 per game and their 26.9 defensive boards per game is tops in the P.L.

HE'S A SHINING STAR AT STABLER

Lehigh head coach Brett Reed is 28-11 at Stabler Arena during his two-plus years at the helm. Reed's win percentage of 71.7% at the STAR ranks third all-time in school annals behind Billy Taylor (76%) and Fran McCaffery (73%).

TURNING UP THE "D"

The Mountain Hawks lead the Patriot League during league play in field goal percentage defense (39%), three-point defense (27%) and scoring margin (+9.4) and have held six of eight opponents under 70 points. During non-league play Lehigh allowed teams to shoot 43% from the field and 37% from downtown.

Lehigh remains at home and welcomes the Black Knights of Army to town on Saturday evening. Tip-off from Stabler Arena on January 13 is set for 7:05.

BAILEY TO JOIN LEHIGH IN 2011

Mackey McKnight: 6-0 point guard from Langham Creek High School (Texas) ... as a junior, averaged 14.6 points, 6.8 assists and 4.3 rebounds per game while shooting 40% from three-point range ... District MVP Runner Up and First-Team All-District honors ... also named to the All-Regional Team.

Kevin McCarthy: 6-9 center who graduated from De La Salle Collegiate High School (Mich.) and is currently attending Philips Exeter Academy (N.H.) ... averaged 10.2 points, 8.2 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game last season ... First-Team All-District and All-League and Second-Team All-State.
