#### SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh puts its first place Patriot League record on the line this afternoon as the Mountain Hawks travel to Easton to take on their archrivals, the Lafayette Leopards inside Kirby Sports Center. Lehigh is gunning for its third straight win after earning a 91-81 come-from-behind win over Colgate on Wednesday in Hamilton, New York. Junior Michael Ojo started only his second career game and responded with a career best 22 points on 6-of-11 shooting, while three other Mountain Hawks hit for double figures. Lafayette has lost four of its last five games, including a 78-67 setback to Bucknell on Wednesday in Lewisburg. The Leopards were without their leading scorer, Jared Mintz, and could not overcome a slow start against the Bison.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In two years on the sideline Reed totaled the second most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first two seasons in school annals. He has also won 70-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for third best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach in 2006-07.

#### IF LEHIGH WINS...

- Lehigh will remain alone in first place in the Patriot League and secure a home game in the quarterfinal round of the upcoming Patriot League Tournament.
- The Mountain Hawks will sweep the Leopards for the first time since the 2005-06 season.
- Lehigh will have won eight road games for the first time since winning eight during the 1990-91 season.

**TODAY'S GAME**

Lehigh and Lafayette meet for the 212th time this afternoon with the Leopards leading the series 136-75. Lehigh won last year's meeting here in Easton, but the Leopards won the previous two meetings at the Kirby Sports Center. The Mountain Hawks used a huge second half comeback to win the first meeting this season, which took place at Stabler Arena last month.

**THE LAST TIME THEY MET**

BETHLEHEM, Pa. (1/23/10) - Lehigh erupted for 45 second half points and held archrival Lafayette to 14.8% shooting in the final 20 minutes as the Mountain Hawks raced past the Leopards 75-57 at Stabler Arena. Freshman C.J. McCollum scored a game-high 23 points for Lehigh, while senior Zahir Carrington added 19 points and classmate Marquis Hall dished out ten assists as the Mountain Hawks won their ninth game at home. Lafayette held a 35-30 lead at halftime and extended to a 37-30 advantage before Lehigh took over. The Mountain Hawks ran off 11 straight to surge in front 41-37, while a Michael Ojo three with 9:23 to go gave LU its first double digit lead of the night. The lead eventually swelled to as many as 19 points.

**LAST TIME OUT**

HAMILTON, N.Y. - Lehigh maintained its hold of first place in the Patriot League with a 91-81 victory over Colgate on Wednesday at Cotterell Court. Four Mountain Hawks scored in double figures, led by junior Michael Ojo's career-high 22 points, while freshman C.J. McCollum also scored 22, senior Marquis Hall added 13 and classmate Zahir Carrington notched a double-double with a season-best 14 rebounds to go along with 12 points.

**FROM DOWNTOWN**

Lehigh has connected on 17-of-36 three-point attempts in its last two games, good for 47.2%. Lehigh currently leads the Patriot League and ranks 27th in America in three-point shooting at 39.0%. The Mountain Hawks have shot 40% or better in 14 games this season.

**THE POINTS KEEP ON COMING**

During its last 15 games Lehigh is averaging 78.1 points on 47.4% shooting. **It marks the first time in school history that Lehigh has scored 70+ points in 15 straight games.** Lehigh, which scored a season-best 91 points in the win at Colgate on Wednesday, currently leads the Patriot League in scoring offense at 74.6 points per contest.

**ROAD WARRIORS**

After going 1-5 in its first six road games, Lehigh has won six of its last eight contests away from home. During those eight games the Mountain Hawks are averaging 80.0 points on 47% shooting, while boasting a +1.1 turnover margin and a +1.4 rebound margin. Lehigh's seven road wins this season are tied for the second most since the inception of Patriot League play in 1990-91.

**HALL LOOKING TO PASS TOP SPOT**

Senior captain Marquis Hall is already Lehigh's all-time assists leader and now the Oregon native has his eyes set on the single season assist record. Hall has dished out 149 helpers this season, which are the third most in one season in school annals. Hall needs 12 more assists to break the record of 160 set by Mike McKee during the 1993-94 season. With Hall leading the way the Mountain Hawks pace the P.L. in assists averaging 14.7 per game.

**LICENSE TO SCORE**

C.J. McCollum continues to fill it up with 15 straight games of double digit points and a 22.2 per game average during Patriot League play. McCollum, who has been named the Patriot League Rookie of the Week on seven different occasions, is the first Lehigh freshman to post five games of 25+ points. McCollum ranks second nationally among freshmen in scoring, and his 459 points are the second most by a freshman in school history behind only Daren Queenan '88, the school's all-time leading scorer.

**YOUNGSTERS UNFAZED BY BRIGHT LIGHTS**

In each of Lehigh's first two games shown on CBS College Sports, a freshman has stolen the spotlight. On January 14 at Navy, C.J. McCollum poured in a then career-high 31 points on 11-of-18 shooting. Two weeks later on January 31 in Worcester, Massachusetts, Gabe Knutson sank 11-of-15 shots as he scored a season best 31 points in Lehigh's first win over Holy Cross at the Hart Center since 1988.

**SCOUTING THE LEOPARDS...**

Head coach Fran O'Hanlon is in his 15th season as the leader of the Lafayette program ... the Leopards lead the Patriot League in field goal percentage, free throw percentage, assists, and assist/turnover ratio .... Lafayette is one of three Patriot League teams with double digit wins at home (Lehigh, Navy) ... Lafayette will honor its three seniors, Michael Gruner, Jeff Kari and Marek Koltun prior to today's contest ... the Leopards are 13-0 this season when shooting 45% or better from the field and 2-11 when shooting 44% or worse.

**BOARD WORK**

In their first nine games of the season the Mountain Hawks were out-rebounded by 4.0 boards per game, but in the last 17 games Lehigh is sporting a +3.8 rebound margin and has out-rebounded 13 of those foes. The Mountain Hawks are currently second in the Patriot League in total rebounds at 37.3 per game and their 26.9 defensive boards per game is tops in the P.L.

**D-FENSE!**

The Mountain Hawks continue to lead the Patriot League during league play in field goal percentage defense (40.8%), three-point defense (31.5%) and scoring margin (+8.2) and have held seven of ten opponents under 70 points. During non-league play Lehigh allowed teams to shoot 43% from the field and 37% from downtown.

**LOOKING TO LOCK IT UP**

Lehigh will secure a home game in the quarterfinal round of the 2010 Patriot League Tournament with a win this afternoon OR a loss by American in its game at Holy Cross.

**NO CLOSE ONES**

The Mountain Hawks are sporting a +14.1 scoring margin in their eight league victories this season with each win coming by 10 points or more. Lehigh's last single digit league win was a 49-40 triumph over Colgate on February 18, 2009. Dating back to last season, ten of Lehigh's last 13 league wins have come by double digits.

**UP NEXT...**

The Mountain Hawks return home to close out the 2010 regular season. First up is a matchup with Bucknell on Wednesday evening at Stabler Arena as Lehigh looks to avenge last month's loss to the Bison. Tip-off on February 24 is set for 7:05.

## NON-LEAGUE SUCCESS

With its win vs. Yale on January 5 Lehigh earned its ninth win of the season. The Mountain Hawks' 19 non-league victories over the course of the past two seasons are their most in a two-year span since the inception of the Patriot League.

## HE'S A SHINING STAR AT STABLER

Lehigh head coach Brett Reed is 29-12 at Stabler Arena during his two-plus years at the helm. Reed's win percentage of 71% at the STAR ranks third all-time in school annals behind Billy Taylor (76%) and Fran McCaffery (73%).

## MARCHING TO THE LINE

The Mountain Hawks have shot 127 more free throws and made 92 more than their opponents this season. Lehigh, which is shooting 71% at the stripe, has attempted more free throws than its opponent in 17 games, including a season best 40 vs. NJIT.

## HALFWAY THERE

Under Brett Reed, the Mountain Hawks are 31-5 when leading at the break, and just 12-27 when trailing at intermission.

## MEN OF STEAL

In their game at Saint Joseph's the Mountain Hawks recorded a season-high 11 steals, including a career-best five thefts by senior captain Marquis Hall. The 11 steals were Lehigh's most since totaling 13 in the opener at Saint Peter's last season (Nov, 2008).

## BALANCED ATTACK

In 29 games a season ago Lehigh was led in scoring by five different players and in rebounding by six. This season, seven Mountain Hawks have led the squad in scoring and eight Mountain Hawks have led the team in rebounds.

**HALL NAMED A FINALIST FOR SENIOR CLASS AWARD**

Marquis Hall is one of ten male finalists for the 2009-10 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, presented annually to an NCAA Division I student-athlete in nine sports. The ten finalists were chosen from a group of 30 men's basketball players from around the country with the winner to be announced during the Final Four. Based on criteria focusing on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition, the award winners will be selected by national balloting of head basketball coaches, national media and college basketball fans. *Lehigh fans can vote at: seniorclassaward.com. **BAILEY TO JOIN LEHIGH IN 2011**

**B.J. Bailey, a 6-2 guard out of Mays Landing, N.J. (Holy Spirit High School),** has transferred to Lehigh from Boston University. Bailey appeared in six games this season for the BU Terriers. Due to NCAA transfer rules, Bailey will sit out the 2010 spring and fall semesters and be eligible to play beginning with the 2011 spring semester.

*Anthony D'Orazio:* 6-2 guard from Camden Catholic High School (N.J.) ... as a junior, averaged 14.7 points, 3.1 rebounds and 3.0 assists, while shooting 47% from the floor ... First-Team Olympic Conference and was named the MVP of the Olympic Cape Challenge and the Prime Time Shootout.

*Mackey McKnight:* 6-0 point guard from Langham Creek High School (Texas) ... as a junior, averaged 14.6 points, 6.8 assists and 4.3 rebounds per game while shooting 40% from three-point range ... District MVP Runner Up and First-Team All-District honors ... also named to the All-Regional Team.

*Kevin McCarthy:* 6-9 center who graduated from De La Salle Collegiate High School (Mich.) and is currently attending Philips Exeter Academy (N.H.) ... averaged 10.2 points, 8.2 rebounds and 2.5 blocks per game last season ... First-Team All-District and All-League and Second-Team All-State.
