SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh heads to Oklahoma City to take part in the 2010 NCAA Tournament in the Midwest Regional at Ford Center. The 16th seeded Mountain Hawks will take on number-one overall seed Kansas on Thursday evening with the winner advancing to Saturday's second round to face either No. 8 UNLV or No. 9 Northern Iowa. Lehigh defeated archrival Lafayette 74-59 on March 12 to win the 2010 Patriot League championship and earn its fourth automatic berth into the Big Dance. Tournament MVP Zahir Carrington led the way for Lehigh with 18 points, 10 rebounds and four blocked shots, while C.J. McCollum, the nation's number-one scoring freshman, netted 20 points en route to earning a spot on the All-Tournament Team.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH BRETT REED

Brett Reed (Eckerd '95) is in his third season as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In three years on the sideline Reed has totaled the most victories by a Lehigh head coach in their first three seasons in school annals. He has also won 70-percent of his games at Stabler Arena, which is good for second best on the Lehigh leaderboard. His 2008-09 accomplishments included Lehigh's most non-league wins ever, the best start to a season in decades, the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a member of the Big East. Reed has been at Lehigh since the 2002-03 season, serving as the associate head coach in 2006-07.

LEHIGH IN THE 2010 P.L. TOURNAMENT

Quarterfinal Round

No. 1 Lehigh 64, No. 8 Army 45

March 3, 2010

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - After scoring only 18 points in the first half, Lehigh's offense got in gear and outscored Army 46-25 in the final 20 minutes as the top-seeded Mountain Hawks outlasted No. 8 Army 64-45 in the quarterfinal round of the 2010 Patriot League Tournament inside Stabler Arena. With the win Lehigh snapped a four-game losing streak in the P.L. Tournament and advanced to the semifinal round for the first time since 2006. 2010 Patriot League Player and Rookie of the Year C.J. McCollum scored 17 of his game-high 19 points after halftime as Lehigh won its 20th game of the season.

Semifinal Round

No. 1 Lehigh 79, No. 4 American 57

March 7, 2010

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - Lehigh raced out to an 11-0 lead on American and never looked back as the top-seeded Mountain Hawks downed the No. 4 American Eagles 79-57 at Stabler Arena to advance to the Patriot League championship game for the first time since 2004. The win was Lehigh's 21st of the season which tied a school record and the Mountain Hawks won their 14th game inside of Stabler Arena to establish a new school record. Freshman C.J. McCollum led four Lehigh players in double figures with 22 points, while senior captain Dave Buchberger tied his season high with 16 points. Stephen Lumpkins led the visitors with 15 points and nine rebounds.

Championship Game

No. 1 Lehigh 74, No. 3 Lafayette 59

March 12, 2010

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - Senior Zahir Carrington scored 18 points, grabbed ten rebounds and blocked four shots en route to leading Lehigh to its first Patriot League championship since 2004 with a 74-59 victory over archrival Lafayette inside of Stabler Arena in front of 4,259 fans. The Mountain Hawks harassed the Leopards into a 3-of-23 showing from three-point range and shot 49% themselves as they won their school record 22nd game this season and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the fourth time in school history. Carrington earned tournament MVP honors, while classmate Marquis Hall and freshman C.J. McCollum were named to the All-Tournament Team. McCollum scored a game-high 20 points, including 16 in the first half, while Hall dished out seven assists and pulled down five rebounds. Ryan Willen led the visitors with 16 points and ten boards.

TOWSON, Md. - Lehigh needed overtime but was able to squeak by Bucknell 76-74 in overtime on a Mike Polaha jumper, to earn its first ever ECC championship and a spot in the NCAA Tournament. Polaha was named the tournament Most Outstanding Player after scoring 20, 25 and 17 points throughout the tournament. ECC Rookie of the Year and First-Team All-Star Daren Queenan pumped in 31 points and pulled down a team-high 12 rebounds on the day.

MARCH 8, 1988

East Coast Conference Championship

Lehigh 84, Towson 78

TOWSON, Md. - Lehigh's all-time leading scorer, Daren Queenan scored 37 points and Mike Polaha added 24, as Lehigh took the ECC title in front of a national television audience on ESPN. Scott Layer added 11 points on 5-of-6 shooting as Lehigh lit up the Towson Center shooting 67% as a team which was a tournament record. Tommy Jones scored a career-high 19 points to lead the Tigers and secure a spot on the All-Tournament Team. It was the third victory for Lehigh against Towson State in as many attempts that season. Polaha was named tournament Most Outstanding Player for the second time in his career, with 85 total points and was joined by Queenan on the All-Tournament Team. Lehigh advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in the last four years.

MARCH 14, 2004

Patriot League Championship

Lehigh 59, American 57

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - Freshman Jose Olivero hit a runner in the lane with 3.8 seconds left to send Lehigh to a 59-57 victory and berth in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1988. The game appeared to be in hand when Olivero hit a three to make the score 52-45 with 5:21 left to play, but American showed it they tied for the regular season title, coming all the way back to tie the game. The Mountain Hawks led by six with 1:21 left to play, but heady play by American's point guard Andres Rodriguez tied the game at 57 with 21 ticks on the clock. Lehigh then brought the ball down and Olivero drove into the lane for the winning shot to give Lehigh its first Patriot League Tournament title in school history. Patriot League Player of the Year Austen Rowland led the team with 14 points on the afternoon, while Jason Mgebroff scored 13 and Olivero added nine. Andres Rodriguez led the Eagles with 16 points, including six in the final 1:21.

Hartford, Conn. - In a matchup touted as "David and Goliath" and "Grandmaster Flash against Little Lehigh", the Brown and White took on the Patrick Ewing-led and eventual Final Four participant Georgetown Hoyas, and hung tough before surrendering 68-43 at the Hartford Civic Center. Mike Polaha scored a game-high 20 points and freshman sensation Daren Queenan ripped down a team-high seven boards.

Hartford, Conn. - Lehigh trailed at the half by just three points, 38-35, but could not get any closer, as it took an outstanding second half performance by Tim Perry (23 second-half points) to lead the No. 1 ranked Temple Owls to an 87-73 victory over the 16th-seeded Brown and White at the Hartford Civic Center. Lehigh was down by four points with 7:01 left in the contest, and by only seven points with 2:19 remaining. However, Temple's Jerome Dowdell hit on seven of eight free throws down the stretch to seal the victory. Mike Polaha led Lehigh with 27 points.

**NCAA Tournament, Opening Round
March 16, 2004**

Dayton, Ohio - Lehigh fell to Florida A&M in the NCAA Opening Round game at Dayton Arena by a score of 72-57 in front of 7,808 to end the Mountain Hawks magical run in 2003-04. Lehigh could not overcome the speed and defensive pressure applied by the Rattlers, and coupled with 29% shooting, Lehigh wound up on the losing end. The Mountain Hawks were led in scoring by Kevin Tempest who tied his career-high with 13 points and was the lone Lehigh player in double digits. Terrance Woods knocked down five three-pointers en route to a game-high 21 points for Florida A&M, which moved onto play Kentucky in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

RICHMOND, Va. (11/13/09) - Lehigh hung with a tough Richmond squad for nearly 39 minutes in its season opener but in the end the Spiders outlasted the Mountain Hawks 65-53 at the Robins Center. Senior captain Marquis Hall led the Brown and White with 14 points, while freshman C.J. McCollum hit for 12 points. Richmond placed four players in double figures led by Kevin Anderson with 16 tallies. Hall and classmate Zahir Carrington led Lehigh with seven rebounds apiece and Hall added six assists.

McCollum was also named to the All-League First-Team as well as the All-Rookie Team. Joining McCollum on the All-League Teams were senior captains Marquis Hall and Zahir Carrington who garnered Second-Team distinction, while freshman Gabe Knutson joined McCollum on the Rookie Team.

THE GRADES ARE IN

During the 2009 fall semester, seven Mountain Hawks achieved a grade point average of 3.0 or better. The list included Dave Buchberger (3.38), Zahir Carrington (3.73), Marquis Hall (3.31), Jordan Hamilton (3.02), Rob Keefer (3.48), Gabe Knutson (3.41) and Matt Shamis (3.60).

AFTER THEY POUND THE BOARDS, THEY POUND THE BOOKS

The average grade point average of Lehigh's starting five of Dave Buchberger, Zahir Carrington, Marquis Hall, Gabe Knutson and C.J. McCollum is 3.2.

MOUNTAIN HAWKS ARE BIG BLUE DEVIL FANS

Senior captain Matt Shamis attended Glenbrook North High School in Illinois where he teamed with current Duke senior Jon Scheyer to lead Glenbrook to a Class AA state championship. Shamis' classmate at Lehigh, Marquis Hall starred for the Portland Legends during his AAU days. Hall's teammate on the Legends was current Duke junior Kyle Singler.

ALL HAIL HALL

Marquis Hall is a two time recipient of the Patriot League Men's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year Award and a three time captain of the Lehigh men's basketball program. A finance major, Hall lists Finance 323 (investments), Corporate Finance and International Relations as the toughest classes he's taken while at Lehigh. **Hall is also an active member of Lehigh's award-winning C.O.A.C.H. program (community outreach) where he travels to local elementary and middle schools to speak with students regarding the importance of hard work, honesty, perseverance and staying in school. Hall is often requested by these local students to come and speak because of the impact he has had on them.**

LOOKING TOWARDS THE FUTURE

Senior Dave Buchberger has plans to explore Medical School once his basketball playing days are over. The native of Cincinnati has also expressed an interest in coaching. **A Biology major, Buchberger says some of the toughest classes he's taken while at Lehigh have been cellular and molecular biology, organic chemistry, behavioral neuroscience and biochemistry.** Buchberger is engaged to his high school sweetheart, Anna Pittman, who is currently attending Ohio State denistry school. They plan to wed this summer in Cincinnati.

CARRINGTON HAS BLOSSOMED AT LEHIGH

A native of Philadelphia, senior Zahir Carrington would like to pursue his master's degree and Ph.D. in sociology once his playing days are behind him. He has long term plans of becoming a college professor. Zahir, whose name means "blossoming" or "flourishing" lists Classical Sociological Theory as his toughest class. During the course students explored the thoughts of classical sociologists dating back to the early 19th century. **In addition to his academic and athletic success, Carrington donates a large portion of his time to extracurricular activities, including Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Boys to Manhood Mentor program where he mentors young men in the Lehigh Valley who have criminal records, and Student Senate, where he represents the entire Lehigh student body, serving as a liaison between students and administrators.**

The Mountain Hawks are 8-0 this season when shooting above 50%. Lehigh, which shot 55% against the Black Knights has won 16 straight games when shooting above 50% with the last loss coming at Notre Dame on November 27, 2006.

FROM DOWNTOWN

Lehigh currently ranks eighth in the nation in three-point shooting at 40.0%. The Mountain Hawks, who have shot 40% or better in 17 games, have made a school record 213 threes this season. Lehigh has hit at least five three-pointers in 25 games.

The Mountain Hawks have shot 185 more free throws and made 135 more than their opponents this season. Lehigh, which is shooting 72% at the stripe, has attempted more free throws than its opponent in 23 games, including a season best 40 vs. NJIT.

HALFWAY THERE

Under Brett Reed, the Mountain Hawks are 35-5 when leading at the break, and just 13-28 when trailing at intermission.

MEN OF STEAL

Lehigh totaled a season best 12 steals in the P.L. semifinal win over American, including a season high four from freshman C.J. McCollum. The 12 steals were the Mountain Hawks' most since recording 13 thefts in the opener at Saint Peter's in November of 2008.

BOARDING SCHOOL

In their first nine games of the season the Mountain Hawks were out-rebounded by 4.0 boards per game, but since that time Lehigh is sporting a +3.7 rebound margin and has out-rebounded 17 of those foes. The Mountain Hawks are second in the Patriot League in total rebounds at 36.5 per game and their 26.3 defensive boards per game is tops in the P.L.
