LEHIGH AT THE 2010 PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

SETTING THE SCENE

No. 1 seed Lehigh will begin its quest for a second straight Patriot League title when it faces the eighth seeded Bucknell Bison Saturday afternoon at 2:30 p.m. in Worcester, Mass. Because of RPI the Mountain Hawks were able to edge out American and clinch the top seed in the tournament. If Lehigh is victorious over the Bison it will play the winner of No. 4 seed Army vs. No. 5 seed Holy Cross Sunday at 1 p.m. The Brown and White is coming off a 65-55 victory over Holy Cross last Saturday. Lehigh was down six points at the half, but shot a season-best 67 percent from the field in the second half to rally over the Crusaders.

LEHIGH-BUCKNELL SERIES

Lehigh maintains a slight edge with a 35-30 lead in the 65 previous meetings. **The Mountain Hawks come into the game winners of the last six games in the all-time series.** Prior to the last two seasons, the Bison had been victorious in the previous three meetings including the last meeting in the postseason during the 2006 Patriot League Tournament. The squads have met three times in the tournament since Patriot League play began, with Lehigh winning two of those three elimination games.

LEHIGH-HOLY CROSS SERIES

The Mountain Hawks have struggled against the Crusaders in the all-time series. Lehigh has only won 10 of the 47 previous meetings, but for the first time the Brown and White won consecutive games over Holy Cross last season. The schools have met seven times in the postseason, with Holy Cross winning all seven of those matchups. **Lehigh has currently won four in a row over the Crusaders, which is the first time in the series history.**

LEHIGH-ARMY SERIES

The Mountain Hawks and Black Knights have met 47 times on the court with all but one of those meetings coming in Patriot League play. Lehigh maintains an advantage in the overall series, 26-21, and in the Patriot League regular season series, 24-17. The schools have met six times in the Patriot League Tournament with each team winning three. **Lehigh has won 13 of the last 17 meetings, including the last four.**

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 15th season at the helm, carrying a career record of 233-202. No other coach in Lehigh's history has won as many overall games or Patriot League contests as Troyan. She received her second Patriot League Coach of the Year honor in 2009 after she guided the team to 26 overall wins, and a Lehigh-record 12 wins against league opponents. Troyan is also a former head softball coach at Lehigh, instantly turning that program into a perennial Patriot League power.

LAST YEAR IN THE TOURNAMENT

Round 1 (LEHIGH 78, Colgate 54) - The Mountain Hawks advanced to the semi-final round of the tournament for the third straight year after knocking off Colgate, 78-54 in the opening round. Erica Prosser and Alex Ross led the team with 19 and 15 points, respectively.

Round 2 (LEHIGH 61, Army 42) - Lehigh rallied to defeat Army 61-42 to advance to its third Patriot League title game. Down three at the half, the Mountain Hawks turned up their defense and took over the game after the break. Erica Prosser scored a team-high 14 points.

Finals (LEHIGH 64, Lafayette 56) - Lehigh defeated its archrival Lafayette 64-56 to win its second P.L. Championship. Alex Ross scored a game-high 21 points en route to being named tournament MVP. Erica Prosser and Melissa Rich were selected the All-Tournament team.

LEAGUE SUPREMECY

For the second straight year Lehigh claimed the top spot in the league after beating out American in RPI. The Mountain Hawks and Eagles had identical 13-1 league records and the RPI was used as the tie breaker.

TOP-25 RECOGNITION

For the third straight week Lehigh received votes in the USA Today/ESPN Division I Top-25 Coaches' Poll. The Mountain Hawks received five votes in the latest poll which came out on Tuesday March 2.

UNSELFISH

If you take a look at one of the Lehigh women's basketball players warm-ups you will notice it has the word "unselfish" on the back. This isn't by coincidence. If you've seen the Mountain Hawks in action you will know why the team has adopted that motto. On any given night any of the players can step up and lead the team on either end of the floor. Despite the fact, Lehigh became the fastest team in Patriot League history to win 15 and 20 games, not one player earned a weekly Patriot League award during the season. This goes to show how well balanced the team is.

GRATCH IS GOING STRONG

Erica Prosser leads Lehigh in scoring (14.1), but that isn't the case in league play. Emily Gratch has been the most consistent scorer as she is averaging 13.3 ppg, which is the fourth highest total in PL play. The First Team All-League rotates in and out of the starting lineup and is shooting .546 this season which leads the Patriot League. Gratch tied her career-high at Bucknell on Feb. 24 with 22 points on 8-for-10 shooting.

13 GAMES AND COUNTING.....

With its win at Holy Cross last Saturday, Lehigh ran its winning streak up to 13 games. The Mountain Hawks are in reach of setting the Patriot League record for consecutive wins, which is 14 by Holy Cross in 1996-97. Here are some stats during the streak:

- The Mountain Hawks are outscoring their opponents by an average of 13.6 points per game.
- Opponents are averaging 48.6 points per game and not one has scored over 60.
- Emily Gratch leads the team during the streak as she is averaging 13.3 points per game in only 24.7 minutes.
- Alexa Williams is averaging 5.8 rebounds per game and Tricia Smith is right behind her with 5.2.
- Lehigh has a +5.7 turnover margin during the streak.

RALLY HAWKS

In the last three games the Mountain Hawks have had to rally in the second half after trailing at the break. Lehigh was down by six points at the break against Holy Cross, which was the largest deficit it faced in league play, and rallied in the second half to win 65-55. The Mountain Hawks are now 6-3 this season when they trail at the half.

IN THEIR FIRST TWO MEETINGS...

Bucknell has had no answer for Emily Gratch this season as she scored a career-high 22 points in both games against the Bison. In the first game against the Bison, Lehigh got a season-high 43 points from its bench as it defeated Bucknell 69-47. In the second game, the Bison led at the half, but the Mountain Hawks turned up their defense and forced 22 second half turnovers. The Brown and White finished the game with a season-best 34 turnovers and held Bucknell to 35 percent shooting.

THREE AMONG THE BEST

Lehigh placed three players on the All-League teams which were announced on Tuesday. Erica Prosser and Emily Gratch were named to the first team, while Alex Ross was named to the second team. It's the second straight year that Prosser earned first team honors and it's the third straight year that Ross was named to the second team. Gratch, the only sophomore named to the first team, receives her first All-League honor.

PROFESSIONAL STEAL WORKER

Erica Prosser, who leads the Patriot League in steals per game (2.8), has 194 for her career which is sixth all-time in Lehigh history. Prosser needs only 12 more to tie Jessica Mudry '96 for the Lehigh single season record for steals (92).

KEY TO LAST YEAR'S P.L. TOURNEY SUCCESS

The Mountain Hawks made their second NCAA Tournament appearance last season after defeating Colgate, Army and Lafayette in the Patriot League Tournament. Lehigh out-scored its opponents 67.7-50.7 (+17) and shot .440 from the field. The Brown and White dominated in almost every category last year including blocks (5.7), rebounds (40.3) and assists (15.7). Lehigh out-rebounded its opponents by a margin of +9.7 per game and Tricia Smith led the team with eight per game. Alex Ross (17.7) and Erica Prosser (12.3) led the team in scoring throughout the tournament.
