SETTING THE SCENE

The 13th annual Christmas City Classic is underway at Stabler Arena and the action will pick back up this afternoon. Lehigh owns a 14-11 record in the Classic and will look to win the title for the second consecutive year today against St. Bonaventure. The Mountain Hawks won their opening round game 69-43 against the Wagner Seahawks. Courtney Dentler led the way as she recorded her first career double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds. The Bonnies defeated IUPUI 69-39 in the first game of the classic to advance to the championship game.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 15th season at the helm, carrying a career record of 217-201. No other coach in Lehigh's history has won as many overall games or Patriot League contests as Troyan. She received her second Patriot League Coach of the Year honor in 2009 after she guided the team to 26 overall wins, and a Lehigh-record 12 wins against league opponents. Troyan is also a former head softball coach at Lehigh, instantly turning that program into a perennial Patriot League power.

LEHIGH IN THE CLASSIC

The Mountain Hawks own a 13-11 record all time in the tournament, earning two championships (2000,2008). The Brown and White has been to the championship game in each of the last five seasons, losing four straight until last season. Lehigh defeated La Salle 58-49 to claim its second CCC Title last year.

LEHIGH VERSUS THE OPPONENTS

The Mountain Hawks have faced two of the three teams in the Classic at least once, with the most history coming against Wagner. The Brown and White has met the Seahawks three times with Wagner holding a 2-1 advantage overall. The teams have not met since 1997-98. Lehigh has faced St. Bonaventure one time in 1986-87, defeating the Bonnies 69-61. Lehigh has never faced IUPUI.

SCOUTING THE SEAHAWKS

Lehigh will meet Wagner in the first game of the Classic. The Seahawks have lost their last five games and come into the game with a 2-8 record. They are 0-7 on the road and this will be the team's fourth Patriot League game. The Seahawks defeated American 73-72, but lost to Colgate (72-59) and Army (74-70).

WAGNER HEAD COACH GELA MIKALAUSKAS

Mikalauskas is in her 16th season as head coach of the Seahawks. She is Wagner's all-time winningest coach and has compiled 195 victories leading the Green & White. Mikalauskas led the Seahawks to a program record 24-wins in 1983-84 and was inducted into the Wagner Athletics Hall of Fame in 1991.

SCOUTING THE BONNIES

St. Bonaventure is putting together a very successful season as it boasts an 11-1 overall record. The Bonnies are coming off their first loss of the season against the No. 16/20 Michigan State Spartans 67-59. St. Bonaventure started the season with 11 straight wins including victories over Binghamton, FDU and Bryant, all of which Lehigh has defeated.

ST. BONAVENTURE HEAD COACH JIM CROWLEY

Crowley is now in his tenth season as St. Bonaventure's head coach and his 14th overall as a coach with the school. Under Crowley's guidance, the Bonnies posted 18 wins in the 2007-08 season, which was the most wins in St. Bonaventure team history. Crowley and the Bonnies followed that up with 24 wins last season.

SHARING THE ROCK

Against Villanova on December 5, five different Mountain Hawks scored in double figures (Prosser 17, Gratch 17, Ross 14, Dalton 12, Dentler 11). It shows how well balanced Lehigh's offensive attack is and on any given night a different player can step up. The last time a Lehigh team had five players score in double figures was a 70-44 victory over NJIT on December 9, 2006. (Adrienne Blount 10, Melissa Rich 11, Sara Ellis 11, Kristen Dalton 11, Alex Ross 10).

LEHIGH'S OPPONENTS GETTING DENTED

Junior Courtney Dentler is making a big impact for the Mountain Hawks this season. Dentler is averaging over 23 minutes a game this season and she has shown her versatility coming off the bench and starting. Dentler has made five consecutive starts and against Duquesne on December, 7 she played a career-high 33 minutes while contributing eight points. Against Binghamton on November 24, Dentler scored a career-high 17 points in the Lehigh victory. Dentler recorded her first career double-double against Wagner on December 29 as she scored 12 points and grabbed 10 rebounds.

WHEN PROSSER HITS 10

When junior point guard Erica Prosser has hit double-figures in points Lehigh has a 31-6 overall record during the last two seasons. In games that she doesn't hit the mark the Mountain Hawks are only 5-3.

FOR THE RECORD

Senior Alex Ross is now Lehigh's all-time leader in three-point field goals with 250. She passed Sara Ellis '07 by hitting two three-pointers in the win over NJIT on December 18. She followed that up by shooting 50 percent from beyond the arc against Bryant (7-for-14) on December 20. Now the question is can Ross pass Holy Cross' Bethany O'Dell and finish as the Patriot League's all-time leader. Heading into the season O'Dell had five more career three-pointers than Ross, but she leads this season 40 to 35.

HITTING THEIR MARK

The Mountain Hawks are 6-0 this season when they score at least 75 points in a game, including a season-high 80 points over Big East foe Villanova. The Brown and White is averaging 69.7 points per game which is tops in the Patriot League.

FROSH LEGS

When you have two All-League selections starting in your back court it is important to have subs that can come in the game to spell them. Freshman Becky Guman has been that for the Mountain Hawks, seeing action in all twelve games. She is averaging 11.6 minutes per game this year. The Brown and White's other three freshmen have also seen action this season, coming off the bench late in games. Kelly Peterson recorded her first career rebounds (4) and had a block against Princeton on December, 2 while she scored her first career-points against Bryant on December, 20. Sarah Pearce came off the bench and scored a career-high four points against NJIT on December, 18.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

With all of the success the women's basketball team had in 2008-09 there was one thing that wasn't accomplished and that was no player recorded a double-double. This season is a different story as two Mountain Hawks have already earned three double-doubles in only twelve games. Sophomore Alexa Williams had 13 points and 15 rebounds to help the Brown and White defeat Lipscomb 77-60. Against FDU, her classmate Emily Gratch recorded her first career double-double as she added 13 points and 11 rebounds to pick up the win 75-45. Courtney Dentler joined the club with 12 points and 10 rebounds against Wagner on December 29.

AS CLASSY AS THEY GET

Junior Erica Prosser is looking to not only repeat as MVP of the Patriot League, but also as MVP of the Christmas City Classic. Last year Prosser helped Lehigh win its second classic title in the 12 year history of the tournament.
