#### SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh will look to win its 21st straight home game tonight when Duquesne comes to Bethlehem. After falling to Princeton 86-68 last Wednesday night, the Mountain Hawks bounced back nicely and defeated Big East foe Villanova 80-65 Saturday night. The Dukes are 2-2 in their last four games after starting the season with four straight victories. Duquesne dropped its last game to Robert Morris 69-61 last Tuesday night. The Dukes will look to improve their all-time record over Lehigh to 3-0 in tonight's game.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 15th season at the helm, carrying a career record of 213-201. No other coach in Lehigh's history has won as many overall games or Patriot League contests as Troyan. She received her second Patriot League Coach of the Year honor in 2009 after she guided the team to 26 overall wins, and a Lehigh-record 12 wins against league opponents. Troyan is also a former head softball coach at Lehigh, instantly turning that program into a perennial Patriot League power.

**SCOUTING THE DUKES**

Despite losing the two-time A-10 Defensive Player of the Year Kristi Little, the Dukes return every other player from last season. Like Lehigh, Duquesne is coming off its most successful season in program history, recording 20 victories and earning a birth in the WNIT. The Dukes are led by sophomore Alex Gensler who is leading the team with 14.5 points per game and 20 three-pointers.

**DUQUESNE HEAD COACH SUZIE McCONNELL-SERIO**

Suzie McConnell-Serio is in her third season at the helm of the Dukes, where she has earned a 41-29 record. The former WNBA coach has helped turn around the Duquesne program as she guided the team to a record 20 wins last season. The Dukes hosted their first ever post season game and set a program-high with 2,208 points scored.

## SHARING THE ROCK

The Mountain Hawks are coming off a game against Villanova where five different players scored in double-figures (Prosser 17, Gratch 17, Ross 14, Dalton 12, Dentler 11). It shows how well balanced Lehigh's offensive attack is and on any given night a different player can step up. The last time a Lehigh team had five players score in double figures was a 70-44 victory over NJIT on December 9, 2006. (Adrienne Blount 10, Melissa Rich 11, Sara Ellis 11, Kristen Dalton 11, Alex Ross 10). Almost three years ago to the exact date, Ross and Dalton took part in the last great balanced attack.

## LEHIGH'S OPPONENTS GETTING DENTED

Junior Courtney Dentler is making a big impact for the Mountain Hawks this season. Dentler is averaging over 23 minutes a game this season and she has shown her versatility coming off the bench and starting. Dentler earned her first start of the season against Princeton and played a game-high 32 minutes while contributing 10 points. Against Binghamton on November 24, Dentler scored a career-high 17 points in the Lehigh victory.

## WHEN PROSSER HITS 10

When junior point guard Erica Prosser has hit double-figures in points Lehigh has a 27-6 overall record during the last two seasons. In games that she doesn't hit the mark the Mountain Hawks are only 5-3.

## REACHING TO THE BENCH

Against Princeton last Wednesday night Lehigh got into foul trouble early and that meant going to its bench. 13 different players saw action in the game and fifth-year senior Ryan Ingalls led the way scoring six points and collecting three rebounds. Senior Kristen Dalton played 25 minutes and sophomore Kelela Blake came in and scored a career-high three points, while collecting two rebounds. The most consistent bench player of the season has been Courtney Dentler who is averaging nearly 10 points per game.

## HITTING THEIR MARK

The Mountain Hawks are 5-0 this season when they score at least 75 points in a game. In its latest victory, Lehigh scored a season-high 80 points over Big East foe Villanova. The Brown and White is averaging 70.4 points per game which is tops in the Patriot League this season.

## FROSH LEGS

When you have two All-League selections starting in your back court it is important to have subs that can come in the game to spell them. Freshman Becky Guman has been that for the Mountain Hawks, seeing action in all seven games. She is averaging 13.4 minutes per game this year. The Brown and White's other three freshmen have also seen action this season, coming off the bench late in games. Kelly Peterson recorded her first career rebounds (4) and had a block against Princeton last Wednesday night. Sarah Pearce scored her first career points off free throws against La Salle on November 29.

## DOUBLE TROUBLE

With all of the success the women's basketball team had in 2008-09 there was one thing that wasn't accomplished and that was no player recorded a double-double. This season is a different story as two Mountain Hawks have already earned a double-double in only eight games. Sophomore Alexa Williams had 13 points and 15 rebounds to help the Brown and White defeat Lipscomb 77-60. Against FDU, her classmate Emily Gratch recorded her first career double-double as she added 13 points and 11 rebounds to pick up the win 75-45.
