SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh heads into tonight's game looking to rebound from its 18-point loss to Princeton on Wednesday night. The Mountain Hawks got into foul trouble early and were unable to develop a rhythm offensively in loss to Princeton. The Brown and White will look to extend its 19-game home winning streak tonight. Villanova comes to Bethlehem on two-game win streak after beating Evansville 56-49 and Chattanooga 64-59 in the Lady Mocs Double Tree Classic.

LEHIGH-VILLANOVA SERIES

This will be the fourth match-up between Villanova and Lehigh. The Wildcats narrowly edged out the Brown and White last season winning 58-52 at The Pavilion. In her first career start Courtney Dentler nearly led the Mountain Hawks to an upset of Villanova as she contributed 13 points and five rebounds.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 15th season at the helm, carrying a career record of 212-201. No other coach in Lehigh's history has won as many overall games or Patriot League contests as Troyan. She received her second Patriot League Coach of the Year honor in 2009 after she guided the team to 26 overall wins, and a Lehigh-record 12 wins against league opponents. Troyan is also a former head softball coach at Lehigh, instantly turning that program into a perennial Patriot League power.

LEHIGH VS THE BIG EAST

The Mountain Hawks have squared off with members of the current Big East 18 times in school history. They have played seven of the 16 teams, having the most success against West Virginia (1-0). Lehigh has earned wins against Seton Hall, Syracuse, Villanova and West Virginia, with the most recent victory coming against Syracuse in 2006. Last season Lehigh went 0-2 against the conference with losses to the Wildcats and Syracuse.

SCOUTING THE WILDCATS

Villanova comes into 2009-10 after losing two players to graduation from last year's team. The Wildcats are off to a great start to the new season with their only loss coming to Massachusetts. Villanova is led by redshirt freshman Laura Sweeney who has come off the bench and averaged 10.6 ppg, along with grabbing 6.2 rebounds per game.

VILLANOVA HEAD COACH HARRY PERRETTA

Harry Perretta is entering his 32nd season at the helm of the Wildcats, where he has earned a 576-344 record. In 2008-09 he guided Villanova to an NCAA Tournament appearance and it was the ninth time in the past 10 years the team has participated in the post season.

LET IT RAIN

Senior guard Alex Ross sits only 11 three-pointers away from becoming Lehigh's career leader. Ross is coming off her most impressive performance of the season against Princeton where she scored a season-high 18 points and was 4-for-8 from beyond the arc. She is averaging 12.0 points per game this season and is hitting 29 percent of her three-pointers.

LEHIGH'S OPPONENTS GETTING DENTED

Junior Courtney Dentler is making a big impact for the Mountain Hawks this season. Dentler is averaging over 23 minutes a game this season and she has shown her versatility coming off the bench and starting. Dentler earned her first start of the season against Princeton and played a game-high 32 minutes while contributing 10 points. Against Binghamton on November 24, Dentler scored a career-high 17 points in the Lehigh victory.

WHEN PROSSER HITS 10

When junior point guard Erica Prosser has hit double-figures in points Lehigh has a 26-6 overall record during the last two seasons. In games that she doesn't hit the mark the Mountain Hawks are only 5-3.

REACHING TO THE BENCH

Against Princeton on Wednesday night Lehigh got into foul trouble early and that meant going to its bench early. 13 different players saw action in the game and fifth-year senior Ryan Ingalls led the way scoring six points and collecting three rebounds. Senior Kristen Dalton played 25 minutes and sophomore Kelela Blake came in and scored three points, while collecting two rebounds. The most consistent bench player of the season has been Courtney Dentler who started her first game against Princeton.

WATCH OUT FOR WILLIAMS

Sophomore Alexa Williams has become quite the thief on the basketball court in 2009-10. Williams not only is Lehigh's leading rebounder (8.7), but she also leads the entire Patriot League in steals per game with 3.0. The 6-3 sophomore has used her height and agility to out work her opponents and steal the ball away. In Lehigh's season opener against Lipscomb Williams recorded a career-high six steals and against St. Francis she had five.

FROSH LEGS

When you have two All-League selections starting in your back court it is important to have subs that can come in the game to spell them. Freshman Becky Guman has been that for the Mountain Hawks, seeing action in all seven games. She is averaging 15 minutes per game this year. The Brown and White's other three freshman have also seen action this season, coming off the bench late in games. Kelly Peterson recorded her first career rebounds (4) and had a block against Princeton. Sarah Pearce scored her first career points off free throws against La Salle last Sunday.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

With all of the success the women's basketball team had in 2008-09 there was one thing that wasn't accomplished and that was no player recorded a double-double. This season is a different story as two Mountain Hawks have already earned a double-double in only six games. Sophomore Alexa Williams had 13 points and 15 rebounds to help the Brown and White defeat Lipscomb 77-60. Against FDU, her classmate Emily Gratch recorded her first career double-double as she added 13 points and 11 rebounds to pick up the win 75-45.
