#### SETTING THE SCENE

Lehigh returns home for the first time in two months for a busy weekend of action in which the eighth-ranked Mountain Hawks will host three duals in two days. The Mountain Hawks will open the weekend against Drexel on Friday night before welcoming EIWA rivals Harvard and Brown for a Saturday doubleheader. Lehigh bounced back from its first dual loss of the season with a 30-13 win at EIWA rival Navy on Saturday night, behind pins from juniors Seth Ciasulli and Mike Galante. The Mountain Hawks have not wrestled a home dual since beating Princeton on November 23, but all seven of Lehigh's remaining duals will be contested inside Leeman-Turner Arena at Grace Hall.

#### FAST FACTS

- Celebrating its 100th season of wrestling, Lehigh's all-time dual meet record stands at 801-380-22, which ranks sixth among all Division I wrestling programs.
- Lehigh will be wrestling Harvard and Brown on the same day in the last weekend in January for the 12th straight year.
- Dating back to the 1997-98 season, Lehigh is a combined 29-1 in dual meets versus Drexel, Harvard and Brown.

**LEHIGH HEAD COACH PAT SANTORO**

Coach Santoro returns to his native Bethlehem for his first season as head coach of the Mountain Hawks. He returns to Lehigh after spending the last five years as the head coach at Maryland where he helped resurrect the Terrapins program, which in 2008 captured its first ACC title in 35 years; a feat which earned Santoro ACC Coach of the Year honors. Santoro posted a 48-41-1 record in five seasons at College Park, including an impressive 33-9 dual mark the last two years. Prior to his stint at Maryland, Santoro spent nine seasons as an assistant coach at Lehigh, including eight as Greg Strobel's top assistant. He was named NWCA Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003 after helping guide the Brown and White to its third EIWA title in four years, and a fourth place finish at the NCAA Championships. A 1992 graduate of the University of Pittsburgh, Santoro won a pair of NCAA titles and is the Panthers only four-time All-American.

Twenty Lehigh Wrestlers have won 26 NCAA championships, ranking fifth nationally. Troy Letters was victorious in 2004 at 165, notching Lehigh's most recent title.

**IN FRONT BY A CHINN**

The lone senior in Lehigh's starting lineup, Trevor Chinn has been making the most of his final season in the Brown and White. Chinn won his first 11 bouts to start the season and is among the team leaders in wins with a 19-6 record. The senior co-captain is Lehigh's highest-ranked grappler in the national polls, at No. 14 at 149. A two-time NCAA qualifier, Chinn boasts a 80-43 career record, including a 45-23 mark in duals.

## SERIES HISTORIES

Lehigh has historically dominated all three teams it will face this weekend. The Mountain Hawks have never lost to Drexel, winning all 14 meetings against the Dragons. Lehigh also holds a current 10-dual winning streak versus Harvard and an 11-dual streak versus Brown.

## NO ORDINARY JOE

Freshman Joe Kennedy is the latest in a recent string of true freshmen who have earned starting spots in the Lehigh lineup. Since the start of the 2005-06 season, seven true freshmen have started duals for the Brown and White, including four last season. Kennedy, who leads the Brown and White with six wins by major decision this season, will look to match Matt Fisk (2006) and David Craig (2007) as true freshman NCAA Qualifiers for the Mountain Hawks.

## GALANTE: GETTING IT DONE

One of the most pleasant surprises for Lehigh this season has been the performance of junior Mike Galante, who leads the team with 20 wins and is ranked 14th at 165. The sixth place finisher in the EIWA a year ago, Galante is currently 14-2 in duals, and leads all regulars with four falls, including a first-period pin of Navy's Matt DeMichiel last weekend.

## THE (CO-)CAPTAINS OF THE SHIP

Senior Trevor Chinn (**Canandaigua, N.Y.**) and junior Matt Fisk (**Wyalusing, Pa.**) will serve as co-captains for the 2008-09 season. Both wrestlers enter this season as two-time NCAA qualifiers and one-time EIWA runner-ups. Fisk also captained the Mountain Hawks last season, while deferring his eligibility.

## NEXT UP...

After wrestling a total of 20 duals in the season's first three months, the Mountain Hawks will be idle next weekend. Lehigh will return to the mats for its final four dual meets in February, beginning with an EIWA showdown against Bucknell on Friday, February 6. All four of Lehigh's remaining duals will be wrestled within the friendly confines of Leeman-Turner Arena at Grace Hall.

### SCOUTING THE DRAGONS

Drexel enters Friday night's dual at 5-11-1 on the dual season. The Dragons are one of the few teams to have wrestled as many duals as the Mountain Hawks at this juncture of the season. Last weekend Drexel competed at the CAA duals in Fairfax, Virginia going 1-2, with a win over Sacred Heart and losses to Old Dominion and Binghamton. The win over Sacred Heart was the 400th career victory for longtime head coach Jack Childs at Drexel. The Dragons boast one nationally ranked grappler in senior Jon Oplinger, who is ranked 12th at 197. Oplinger is also one of five Lehigh Valley natives listed among the Drexel probable starters and one of three who attended Northampton High School. A fourth Northampton grappler, Steve Mytych, would be ranked at 125 but has been out of action with an injury.

### SCOUTING THE CRIMSON

Harvard returns to the mats for the first time in three weeks with duals this weekend at Lehigh and Army. The Crimson have been off since a 1-2 showing at the Lone Star Duals on January 3. It was there that Harvard picked up its first win of the dual season, 24-21, over Stanford. The Crimson also dropped duals to Cal Poly and Minnesota to fall to 1-5 on the dual season. Harvard also competed at the Las Vegas Invitational and the Midlands Championships. Allentown native Jay Weiss is in his 15th season as head coach of the Crimson. Individually, Harvard has three wrestlers ranked in the top ten nationally. J.P. O'Connor is ranked fourth at 157, while Louis Caputo comes in at No. 7 at 184. Sophomore Corey Jantzen is ranked No. 3 at 141 but is not expected to compete this weekend.

### SCOUTING THE BEARS

Brown comes into Saturday's dual with a 2-6 dual record, including an 0-3 mark against EIWA opponents. Last weekend, the Bears fell, 20-12, at home to Bucknell. Like Harvard, Brown competed at both the Las Vegas Invitational and the Lone Star Duals. In Texas, longtime head coach Dave Amato picked up career win No. 350 in a 26-6 triumph over Air Force. Aside from Bucknell, the Bears have also dropped conference duals to American and Rutgers, and like Harvard, Brown will head to West Point, N.Y. to face Army on Sunday. The Bears have zero nationally ranked wrestlers, but Brown does have two men ranked by the EIWA: senior Matt Gevelinger at 184 and senior Branden Stearns at 197.
