#### SETTING THE SCENE

The final dual meet of the regular season pits No. 8 Lehigh against EIWA rival and 25th-ranked Penn. The Mountain Hawks ran their dual record to 22-1 with wins over conference foes Army and Franklin & Marshall last weekend, and Lehigh can set a new single-season record for dual wins with a victory over the Quakers. Penn has won five of its last six duals to move back into the national rankings. The Quakers finished second in the EIWA last year and boast three nationally-ranked wrestlers. Penn will host the EIWA Championships at the Palestra in two weeks. Today's dual also marks the final home appearance for Lehigh seniors Trevor Chinn, Jamie O'Dowd and Samir Soriano.

#### FAST FACTS

- Celebrating its 100th season of wrestling, Lehigh's all-time dual meet record stands at 807-380-22, which ranks sixth among all Division I wrestling programs.
- The Mountain Hawks 22 dual wins match the highest single-season total in school history. Lehigh is also tied with Iowa for the most dual wins in Division I this season.
- Lehigh is 48-5 in dual meets against EIWA opponents since the start of the 2002-03 season. Penn is the only EIWA team to beat Lehigh twice during that span.

**FEBRUARY 24, 2008 - PHILADELPHIA, PA.**  
**PENN 24 - LEHIGH 15**

Thomas Shovlin scored a third-period pin over Lehigh's Alex Iacocca to break a 15-15 tie and give No. 25 Penn a 24-15 win over the Mountain Hawks at the famed Palestra. Lehigh won just four of ten bouts, highlighted by Trevor Chinn's 4-1 tiebreaker victory over No. 14 Cesar Grajales at 149. Bonus points were key early on as the first three bouts all produced them. After a technical fall for Penn's Rollie Peterkin at 125, Seth Ciasulli gave Lehigh the lead with a first period pin of Phil Boyer at 133. A major decision at 141 put the Quakers back in front before Lehigh claimed three of the next four bouts to take a 15-12 lead. Penn however, took the final three bouts to rally for the win.

**LEHIGH HEAD COACH PAT SANTORO**

Coach Santoro returns to his native Bethlehem for his first season as head coach of the Mountain Hawks. He returns to Lehigh after spending the last five years as the head coach at Maryland where he helped resurrect the Terrapins program, which in 2008 captured its first ACC title in 35 years; a feat which earned Santoro ACC Coach of the Year honors. Santoro posted a 48-41-1 record in five seasons at College Park, including an impressive 33-9 dual mark the last two years. Prior to his stint at Maryland, Santoro spent nine seasons as an assistant coach at Lehigh, including eight as Greg Strobel's top assistant. He was named NWCA Assistant Coach of the Year in 2003 after helping guide the Brown and White to its third EIWA title in four years, and a fourth place finish at the NCAA Championships. A 1992 graduate of the University of Pittsburgh, Santoro won a pair of NCAA titles and is the Panthers only four-time All-American.

**PENN HEAD COACH ROB EITER**

Coach Eiter is in his first season as the head coach at Penn after spending the previous two seasons as an assistant under Zeke Jones. Prior to coming to Penn, Eiter coached at Northwestern, working as a volunteer assistant from 1997-2002 before serving as a full-time assistant for the next four seasons. An accomplished freestyle competitor and coach, Eiter was an alternate on the 1992 U.S. Olympic team and placed eighth at the 1996 Olympics. He is a 1991 graduate of Arizona State.

**IN FRONT BY A CHINN**

The lone senior in Lehigh's starting lineup, Trevor Chinn has been making the most of his final season in the Brown and White. Chinn won his first 11 bouts to start the season and leads the team with a 24-7 record. The senior co-captain is currently ranked No. 15 at 149. A two-time NCAA qualifier, Chinn boasts a 85-44 career record, including a 50-24 mark in duals.

### SCOUTING THE QUAKERS

Penn enters the weekend at 11-6 overall and 6-2 against EIWA opponents. Before visiting Bethlehem on Sunday, the Quakers will square off against Penn State on Friday in State College. Penn fell at Cornell 24-9 last Sunday in Ithaca, N.Y., a loss which snapped a five winning streak for the Quakers. Like Lehigh, Penn competed at the Las Vegas Invitational in December and the Virginia Duals in January. Last year, the Quakers placed second in the EIWA, just half a point behind Cornell. Despite just three ranked wrestlers in its lineup, Penn brings a dangerous, veteran team into Sunday's dual. The Quakers three ranked grapplers are junior Rollie Peterkin (No. 11 at 125), senior Cesar Grajales (No. 11 at 149) and senior Matt Dragon (No. 18 at 157).

### CHASING HISTORY

At 22-1, Lehigh has matched the 2004 team for the highest single-season dual win total in school annals. With a win today, Lehigh would set a new school record for dual wins in a season. Here's a look at the top five dual-win seasons in Lehigh's 100 year history:
