



## **General Medical Clinic Protocol**

General Medical Clinic is held weekly during the school year (excluding holiday weeks) starting at 5:30pm in the Cundey Varsity House Athletic Training Room. This is a time when student-athletes are able to see our General Medical Team Physician if it is deemed necessary by one of the Sports Medicine Staff members. In addition, a member of the Lehigh Sports Medicine Staff will be present each evening to facilitate the process and to interact with the doctor on each student-athlete's behalf. The following is the protocol as well as the rules and regulations for attending the General Medical Clinic.

1. The University's Health and Wellness Center is our primary resource for general medical care. The following steps should be followed for Health and Wellness Center referral.
  - a. Pick up a Health and Wellness Center referral form from a member of Sports Medicine
  - b. Schedule an appointment or walk-in at the Health and Wellness Center
  - c. Return paperwork to a member of the Sports Medicine Staff
2. A member of the Sports Medicine Staff will determine if it is necessary for the student-athlete to see the team physician at the General Medical Clinic.
3. If possible, all student-athletes attending General Medical Clinic should be showered and dressed appropriately for evaluation (athletic clothes, shorts for leg injuries, etc.).
4. In the event that a student-athlete cannot attend a General Medical Clinic session that he/she is scheduled for it is his/her responsibility to contact a Sports Medicine Staff member and tell them.
